RELATIVE TO COMMENDING AND CONGRATULAING REAR ADMIRAL WILLIAM D. FRENCH, UNITED STATES NAVY, ON HIS SECOND STAR PROMOTION TO REAR ADMIRAL UPPER HALF, AND TO EXPRESSING OUR SINCERE UN DANG'KULO NA SI YU'OS MA'ASE FOR HIS SUPPORT OF THE PEOPLE OF GUAM AND THE MAYORS' COUNCIL OF GUAM. 1

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYORS' COUNCIL OF GUAM:

WHEREAS, Rear Admiral William D. French, assumed Flag command of the
U.S. Naval Forces Marianas, U.S. Defense Representative Guam, Commonwealth of the
Northern Mariana Islands, Federated States of Micronesia, and the Republic of Palau in April
2007; and

6 WHERAS, in the area of Personal Excellence Partnership, countless volunteer hours 7 were dedicated by the various commands under his leadership in the area of education, namely 8 tutoring in after school programs, Saturday Scholars programs, mentoring, and serving as role 9 models inside and outside of the classroom, all of which helped improve scholastic 10 achievement, social and life skills and provided vocational guidance; and

WHEREAS, in the areas of Health, Safety, and Fitness, countless volunteer hours were dedicated by the various commands under his leadership by participating in projects that included athletic events, health and safety awareness activities and programs, blood drives, youth violence prevention programs and recreational programs, and especially the Guam Special Olympics; and

WHEREAS, in the area of the Campaign for a Drug Free Flagship, commands under his leadership reached out and taught about the dangers of drug abuse to the various public and private school children at all grade levels, including but not limited to the Drug Education for Youth, Drug Abuse Resistance Education and the Red Ribbon Campaign; and

20 WHEREAS, in the area of Project Good Neighbor Flagship, countless volunteer hours 21 were dedicated by the various commands under his leadership to special projects within our 22 community which included helping the less fortunate and strengthening and improving 23 community relations through food drives, repairs and renovations of our island's historical 24 sites, shelters, schools and homes; in addition Rear Admiral William D. French, in recognition of 25 the crucial role of education in our nation's future, matched every command with every village 26 and public school in a sister village and sister school status, thus making thousands of volunteer 27 sailors available to support ongoing school scholar projects and assist in the enrichment of 1 Guam's youth, setting the example of community service as a lifelong endeavor in which Sailor 2 and Guam's youth can develop leadership, character, and responsible citizenry; and

3 WHEREAS, in the area of Environmental Stewardship, countless volunteer hours were 4 dedicated by the various commands under the Admiral's leadership to programs that promoted 5 good environmental education and good stewardship of environmental resources; he 6 encouraged Navy commands to join with our communities to assist in the local environmental 7 initiatives, beautification projects, clean-ups, and restoration of environmental assets to include 8 the preservation and stewardship of numerous historic sites on Naval Base Guam including the 9 location of the former Village of Sumay and the Sumay cemetery; and

10 WHEREAS, Rear Admiral William D. French embraced the people of Guam for the 11 purpose of gaining new friendships and forging better understanding between the military and 12 the local communities, engaging often with residents as well as informally and officially with the 13 island's elected and business leadership; and

14 WHEREAS, Rear Admiral William D. French as well showed his commitment to the people of 15 Guam through his initiatives and dedication to enhancing the sailor/local veteran relationship and in 16 meeting the unique challenge of a resident military retiree population significantly larger per capita than 17 most regions and installations, the Admiral astutely balanced application of resources and skillfully 18 brought to fruition the initial stages of construction of a new \$5M Veterans Community Based Outpatient 19 Clinic in a location more accessible for Guam veterans; and;

20 WHEREAS, Rear Admiral William D. French skillfully guided the initial stages of the 21 move of US Marines from Okinawa in one of the largest peacetime build-ups in naval history 22 while striving to make the changes understandable to the people of Guam, in spite of its 23 incredible complexity and involvement of local, federal, and foreign governments with diverse 24 and complicated political, legal, and financial issues; and

WHEREAS, Rear Admiral William D. French's various commands deployed hundreds 25 26 of sailors in support of Operations IRAQI FREEDOM and ENDURING FREEDOM while 27 simultaneously developing benchmark programs and policies on how to sponsor and support 28 Sailors and their families before, during, and after deployment; and

29 WHEREAS, through his selfless actions, tireless efforts and unwavering commitment to 30 excellence in all his undertakings Rear Admiral William D. French received numerous awards, 31 recognitions, accolades and certificates from island's various civic, non-profit groups and government organizations for his leadership and guidance and helping to improve the lives of
 the people of Guam; and

3 WHEREAS, the Mayors' Council of Guam would also like to recognize his lovely wife 4 Monika, and his son Thomas and daughter Teressa for their love and support of their father 5 during his command on Guam, and the Mayors' Council wishes all of Gods goods blessings 6 and success for the entire French family as the Admiral assumes his new post as the 7 Commander of the Southwest Region, San Diego, California; and

8 WHEREAS, the Mayors' Council of Guam deeply and truly appreciates the efforts and 9 friendship of Rear Admiral William D. French in both his personal and official roles, and 10 recognizes that they have never encountered such an engaging and willing Naval officer of his 11 rank, and now therefore be it

12 **RESOLVED**, that the Mayors' Council of Guam does hereby commend and congratulate 13 William D. French, Rear Admiral, United States Navy, on his second star promotion to Rear Admiral 14 upper half, and to express our sincere Un Dang'kulo na Si Yu'os Ma'ase for his support of the people of 15 Guam and the Mayor's Council of Guam: *and be it further*
