1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY KONSEHELON MAHOT GUÅHAN:**

2 **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Vicente Salas San Nicolas was born on February
3 28, 1935 to the late Francisco Taijeron San Nicolas and the late Pilar Lujan Salas; and was called
4 to go back home to his eternal rest on July 5, 2009, at the age of seventy-four (74); and

5 **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Vicente Salas San Nicolas met and married a devoted
6 and faithful woman, Teresita Divera (Ignacio), and together were blessed with eleven (11)
7 children, Philomena, Germaine, Vincent, Stephanie, Pergrine, Ursulyn, Dymphnia, Sophia,
8 Wilbert, Apolline, and Ledwynn; and five(5) reared children, Jeremiah, Geraldine, Harlan,
9 Michael, and Millard; and they were further blessed with twenty-two (22) grandchildren; and
10 sixteen (16) great-grandchildren; and

11 **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Vicente Salas San Nicolas was an ardent and dedicated
12 youth sports supporter who helped hundreds of youth from all over Guam, umpired and
13 officiated for many Little League, Babe Ruth, and Guam Amateur Baseball League games, all
14 for the benefit of supporting sports; and

15 **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Vicente Salas San Nicolas was elected by the people of
16 Chalan Pago- Ordot as Commissioner(now called Mayor) in 1975 and was further elected
17 Mayor in every subsequent Mayoral election until his retirement on September 30, 1995; and

18 **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Vicente Salas San Nicolas also served in various boards
19 and organizations and was also active in civic and religious organizations including Our Lady
20 of Peace and Safe Journey Parish Council, the Knights of Columbus, the Boy Scouts of America
21 Troop 19, The George Washington High School Advisory Council, the Chalan Pago-Ordot
22 Family Association, the Guam Babe Ruth Prep League, and the Guam Amateur Baseball
23 League; and

24 **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Vicente Salas San Nicolas will be missed but never
25 forgotten and his legacy lives on through his honorable service to God and to his island and in
26 the memories of his wife, children, grand-children, great-grandchildren, his in-laws and their
27 spouses, his numerous relatives and friends; and his God-Children; and

28 **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Vicente Salas San Nicolas, throughout his life, was an
29 important and valuable asset in the development of Guam’s social, economic, and political

1 history; but most especially, in the development of Guam's youth and sports facilities; *now*
2 *therefore be it*


3 **RESOLVED**, that the *Konsehelon Mahot Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of the people of

9 *and be it further*


10 **RESOLVED**, that the President certify, and the Secretary of the Council attest to, the
