The reimbursement grant provides funding to secure relevant training to enable OPA audit staff to produce timely and professional quality audit products. The grant expires on March 31, 2010.

For the period April 1, 2009 through June 30, 2009, the OPA did not receive reimbursements during this period. Because this is a reimbursement grant, eligible training expenses incurred during the third quarter will be submitted for reimbursement processing in the fourth quarter. The OPA did not incur, report, or submit reimbursement for any disallowed costs during this reporting period.
