Note 1:

GovGuam apppropriation revenue of \$27.2M is based on accrual basis of accounting.

Cash received as of July 31, 2009 is \$21.9 M . Therefore, GovGuam is \$5.3M in arrears for FY09 allotments.

Using cash basis of GovGuam appropriations, the change in net assets would be a decrease of \$7.1M as of July 31, 2009 Accounts receivable for FY 2007 is \$138,569K and for FY08 is \$226K, based on an allotment control settlement with GovGuam.
