1           **BE IT RESOLVED BY KONSEHELON MAHOT GUÅHAN:**

2           **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Jesus Babauta Chaco was born on March 31, 1946  
3 to the late Juan Rivera Chaco and the late Ana Babauta Chaco; and was called to go  
4 back home to his Creator on November 11, 2009, at the age of sixty-three (63); and

5           **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Jesus Babauta Chaco met and married a devoted  
6 and faithful woman, Virginia “Bea” Baza Balajadia, and together were blessed with four  
7 (4) children, Jesse “Junior”, June, Jeff, and John Vincent; and they were further blessed  
8 with nine (9) grandchildren; and four (4) great-grandchildren; and

9           **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Jesus Babauta Chaco was an ardent and dedicated  
10 community service volunteer for the Mount Carmel Parish Council, The Mount Carmel  
11 Knights of Columbus, and the Eucharistic Ministers of Agat and in his younger years as  
12 a member of the Agat Drill Team, the Agat Scouts Program, and the Holy Name  
13 Society; and

14           **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Jesus Babauta Chaco was elected by the people of  
15 Agat as Vice Mayor in November, 1996 and was re- elected Vice Mayor in 2000, 2004,  
16 and 2008; and

17           **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Jesus Babauta Chaco also worked in various  
18 capacities with the Ship Repair Facility (SRF), the Guam Legislature and the Office of  
19 the Suruhanu and was a loyal public servant to the people of Agat and the Agat  
20 Municipal Planning Council; and

21           **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Jesus Babauta Chaco will be missed but never  
22 forgotten and his legacy lives on through his honorable service to God and to his island  
23 and in the memories of his wife, children, grand-children, great-grandchildren, his son-  
24 in-law George L. Charfauros, his daughters-in-law Pauline R. Chaco and Ali Jo Sablan,  
25 his brothers and sisters and their spouses, his in-laws and their spouses, his numerous

1 relatives and friends, his God-Children, and his colleagues in the Mayors' Council of  
2 Guam; and

3 **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Jesus Babauta Chaco, throughout his life, was an  
4 important and valuable asset in the development of Guam's social, economic, and  
5 political history; but most especially, in the development of the village of his beloved  
6 hometown, Agat; *now, therefore be it*

9 Jesus Babauta Chaco for his long, dedicated, and unselfish service; *and be it further*


10 **RESOLVED**, that the *Konsehelon Mahot Guåhan* does hereby extend a heartfelt *Si*

13 extended family, friends and relatives; *and be it further*


14 **RESOLVED**, that the President certify to, and the Secretary attest to the adoption
