WHEREAS, the Hospital has realized Twenty-Eight Thousand Nine Hundred Fourteen Dollars and Cents Seventy-Two (\$28,914.72) in revenues since the inception of the new fees in FY2009/2010; now therefore be it,

RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees accepts and approves the recommendation of the Finance & Audit Committee and adopts the Twenty-Eight (28) new fee items, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Chairperson certifies and the Secretary attests to the adoption of this resolution.

MINUTES

In accordance with the Administrative Adjudication Law, a public hearing was held on Friday, December 18, 2009, at 9:30 a.m. in the GMHA Medical Library Conference Room, to solicit public opinion on the Hospital's 28 New Rates Fees and Charges.

Present were: (Refer to Exhibit 10 - GMHA Public Hearing Attendance Sheet).

Note: Copies of the Public Hearing Agenda (Refer to Exhibit 9 – GMHA Public Hearing Agenda) and the Listing of Hospital Fees (Refer to Exhibit 3 - GMHA Summary of Fee Items/Services) were made available to all attendees.

I. Introduction

Ms. Frances Danieli introduced herself as the Presiding Public Hearing Officer for this public hearing. Our public hearing recorder was Mrs. Candy Chan. Ms. Danieli began conducting the public hearing at 9:48 a.m., Friday, December 18, 2009.

She indicated that this public hearing was originally advertised to start at 9:30 a.m. but we had allowed a grace period of fifteen minutes for additional attendees from the public to attend this hearing.

II. Opening Remarks

On behalf of the GMHA Board of Trustees, the Hospital Administrator, the Chief Financial Officer, and the GMHA employees, Ms. Danieli welcomed the public for being present at the public hearing.

III. Purpose of the Public Hearing

Ms. Danieli stated that the purpose of this public hearing was as enacted in Public Law 26-66 in December 2001, which removed the rate-setting jurisdiction from the PUC and gave it to the GMHA Board of Trustees. It was noted under:

10 GCA §80105 Hospital Rates

“(b) The Authority may establish interim fees for new, un-tariffed services, medication and supplies, without prior legislative approval and without compliance with the Administrative Adjudication Law; provided, that : (1) the interim fees are consistent with the Authority’s Net Revenue Enhancement Engagement Pricing Model, as prepared by Deloitte & Touche, dated February 7, 1992, or such other protocol as may be approved by the Board of Trustees; and (2) a petition for permanent approval of the interim fees is filed by the Authority with I Liheslaturan Guahan within three (3) months of the Authority’s establishment of the interim fee.”

Ms. Danieli added that the Hospital had a total of twenty-five (25) public hearings during fiscal years 2002 through 2009. A total of 3,335 new fees and a total of 2,181 rate increase items had been introduced and adjudicated.

In compliance with the Administrative Adjudication Law and the Guam Code Annotated directives, the Hospital published the announcement of this public hearing in the Pacific Daily News (Refer to Exhibit 5 – GMHA Newspaper Notices of Public Hearing). The Notice was also distributed to the Hospital departments and units and also posted in various public areas within the Hospital.

In addition, the Hospital also sent the Notice via facsimiles to various news media organizations, the Offices of the Governor and Lieutenant Governor, the Congressional Representative, and to our elected Senators of the 30th Guam Legislature (Refer to Exhibit 6 - GMHA Fax Notifications of Public Hearing). In addition, letters were sent to the third party payers inviting them to this public hearing with the listing of new fees. (Refer to Exhibit 7 - Letters inviting Third Party Payers to Public Hearing).

The Hospital also posted the Notice on its official website as mandated by public law. (Refer to Exhibit 8 – Press Release Notice of Public Hearing displayed on GMHA website).

IV. Presentation of Summary of New Fee Items

Mr. Frumen Patacsil introduced himself being in charge of the Hospital’s Charge Library. He indicated that we were presenting today a total of Twenty-Eight (28) new fee items submitted by two departments of the Hospital for the past three months. The summary of these fee items/services were as follows:

V. Testimonies from the Public

Ms. Danieli referred to anyone who had signed up for testimony regarding these new fees. It was noted that no attendee had signed up for testimony. Ms. Danieli indicated that the public could submit a written testimony within five (5) days after this public hearing. These testimonies would be incorporated into the submission package to the 30th legislature subsequent to the approval by the Board of Trustees.

VI. Questions and Answers on the Hospital Rates Fees and Charges

Ms. Danieli would like to solicit from the public any questions they might have for this public hearing concerning the new fees. It was noted that no questions were presented by the attendees at this public hearing.

VII. Closing Remarks





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Royals nip Geckos in epic fashion

The Notre Dame Royals are in the Independent Inter-scholastic Athletic Association of Guam Boys' Soccer League semifinals by the narrowest of margins.

In a match that could only be considered as epic, the Royals forced extra time via a last-gasp equalizer after being down

3-0 at halftime. They then scored in the first extra time, and allowed an equalizer in the second overtime period before surviving four misses in the penalty kick shootout to win 13-12 over the George Washington Geckos last night at GW field.

"We were too complacent," Royals coach Noel Casilao said of the halftime deficit. "Maybe (the players) thought because we beat them 6-0 before that it would be an easy game," he said, adding that the Geckos also benefited by the return of several players that weren't available during the regular season.

The Royals now face the top-seeded Father Duenas Friars Thursday at 4:30 p.m. at GFA's Harmon field for a spot in Saturday's final.

The Royals should have taken an early first-half lead yesterday when the Geckos were called for a pass back, but Joel Piper's effort from the free kick layoff was blocked and cleared by the de-

fense. The Geckos took advantage in the 7th minute when Scott Spindel poked home from a yard out after Royals goalkeeper Randy Del Priore failed to deal with a high ball in the box. Spindel's older brother Shawn then got in

out any real close calls before a late foul on the edge of the box gave the Royals a free kick. Jude Bischoff stepped up and struck a hard grounder that took a couple deflections before finding the back of the net with only a minute left, sending it to extra time.

The Royals completed the fightback in the fifth minute of the first extra period when Jacques Diambra-Odi fired a left-footed shot

past Geckos keeper Zacarias Bukikosa, but Scott Spindel scored his second with a minute left to force the dramatic penalty kick shootout.

The Royals, who kicked first, failed to convert their spot kicks four times, but each time the Geckos returned the favor to keep the score even. Then, with the 18th kick, Cruz scored off the post for the Royals and the Geckos' Luke Atkinson put his shot over the crossbar to end the match.

"They (the Royals) pushed more people forward and we got caught at our backside," Geckos coach Matt Naputi said of the Royals' comeback.

Fortunately for the Geckos, only two starters are seniors and should field a strong team next season.

"There's a good core of players ... I believe we can be playoff contenders next year," Naputi said.

sending them to the bronze medal match against Hong Kong. They couldn't duplicate their performance of the previous day and lost the bronze medal match 15-0. The team became a crowd favorite throughout the rugby days, gaining fans and getting many cheers and post-event respect.

Athletics

Derek Mandell and Nicole Layson represented Guam in the 800-meter run. Mandell was a second off his personal best time, while Layson was 16 seconds off her best time in the two-lap event.

Judo

R.J. Blas Jr. fought twice in the superheavyweight plus 100-kilogram division. He lost his opening match against China's Jian Liu by ippon and, in his bronze medal match, lost by ippon to Korea's Soowhan Kim. Blas injured his left knee in the second contest and was medically forced to withdraw from open competition the next day. Guam's other fighter, Gen Imai, lost his two matches by ippon as well, first to Hui Li of China and then to Dagvador Bayarmagnai of Mongolia.

Table tennis

Arman Burgos and Edwin Cadag lost their opening match 4-0 to Taipei, scoring 3, 3, 2 and 3 points in each game to 11. In singles, Burgos fell 4-0 to China's Ji Zhang, scoring 3 points in each game lost. Cadag also lost to Hong Kong's Chig Li, scoring 2, 2, 4 and 3 points in each game.

Taekwondo

Guam's Kevin Na, fighting in the under-58 kilogram class, lost to Korea's Chulho Lim but did score a point against the eventual gold-medal winner, 7-1. And Gilbert Pascua, fighting in the under-62 kilogram division, lost his only fight to Hong Kong's Chun Poon but with four competitors (Mongolia was disqualified), managed Guam's only medal of the Games.

Bowling

Guam's six-man team of Jay Leon Guerrero, Frank Russo, Keith Guerrero, Brian Manibusan, Joey Miranda III and Robert Baker had its ups and down throughout the weeklong events, generally finishing near the middle of the pack with occasional highlights. A bright spot was Jay Leon Guerrero's 13th-place finish of the 43 bowlers entered in singles. In doubles, Guam placed 13th, 16th and 18th out of 21 teams. In trios, Guam placed 9th and 11th out of 14 teams, though two countries entered 2-man squads. And finally, in the team of five division, Guam finished last of six teams.

5 GCA § 10306 (2004)

§ 10306. Information Required on Official Home Pages.

The following information is required to be posted on each Official Home Page for each Branch of the government of Guam:

Notice of Meetings and Public Hearings. Notice of all public meetings, public hearings and other public events for which notice is required under the provisions of Public Law, or applicable rules and regulations, shall be posted on the applicable Official Home Page by the minimum period of notice required for such meetings. Such notices posted shall include information generally required to be included in the publication of such notices.

The e-mail addresses of all official offices, departments, agencies and instrumentalities of the Branch of government.

Any web sites or home pages of all official offices, departments, agency and instrumentality of the Branch of government.
