

**CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO I MAGA'LAHEN GUÅHAN**

**AN ACT TO PLACE THE *MERIZO* PIER PARK UNDER THE ADMINISTRATIVE JURISDICTION OF THE *MERIZO* MAYOR'S OFFICE, BY *ADDING* A NEW ITEM (20) TO §40113(b) OF CHAPTER 40, TITLE 5, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED.**

1        **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2        **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** The *Merizo* Mayor has  
3 requested to have administrative jurisdiction of the *Merizo* Pier Park and would  
4 like to have *sole* control of the property. Since assuming office, the Mayor has  
5 painted the pavilions and has been up-keeping the *Merizo* Pier Park by disposing of  
6 trash. The Mayor has also provided water service to all the pavilions, including the

1 installation of shower heads for use by individuals who fish and swim in the area.  
2 The cost of the additional maintenance and services provided at the *Merizo* Pier  
3 Park has been absorbed by the *Merizo* Mayor's Office with *no* intention of any  
4 request for additional funds.

5 **Section 2. Transfer of Administrative Jurisdiction.** *I Liheslaturan*  
6 *Guåhan* does hereby transfer the *Merizo* Pier Park from the administrative  
7 jurisdiction of the Department of Parks and Recreation to the administrative  
8 jurisdiction of the *Merizo* Mayor's Office. The transfer of said administrative  
9 jurisdiction *shall* become effective *no later than* one hundred twenty (120) days  
10 from the enactment of this Act.

11 **Section 3.** A new Item (20) is hereby *added* to §40113(b), Chapter 40 of  
12 Title 5, Guam Code Annotated, to read as follows:

13 “(20) The Mayor of *Merizo* is responsible for the *Merizo* Pier Park.  
14 The authority for allowing use of the facility and assessment of authorized  
15 fees, as currently exercised by the Department of Parks Recreation, shall be  
16 made a part of the granting of this responsibility, in the interim, until the  
17 Mayor, through the AA process, formulates a new fee structure or new rules  
18 and regulations.”
