Re: Department of Education Financial Status

Dear Governor Camacho:

Hafa Adai! As you know, over the past several months the Department of Education has had to use local funds for the salaries and benefits of employees that are funded by the Consolidated Grant. To date we have spent up to \$4.5 million in our effort to sustain the programs and ensure that the services to our students are not disrupted. Today, given the shortage of cash collections, the Department of Administration was only able to release \$500,000, which is \$2.3 million short of what is needed to pay payroll vendors for locally funded employees and those who are funded by the Consolidated Grant.

We fully understand the dire financial condition in which the Government is operating. However, DOE will not be able to continue paying the salaries and benefits of more than 500 federally funded employees unless additional cash is released. DOE also has not been able to pay non-payroll vendors because to date DOA has not remitted more than \$7 million of our approved allotment.

On January 27, 2010 I sent a letter to Phil Maestri requesting approval to draw down on the FFY 2008 carryover funds. I provided a copy of that letter to you. To date I have not received a written response to my request, although email messages from the Consolidated Grant program specialist has indicated that the documents are under review.

I implore your assistance in identifying a source of funding that can be used until we get the approval from USDOE. This will be reimbursable.

We do not want to disrupt the services to our students. But I am sure you know that I cannot allow our employees to continue working without an adequate funding source. As such, in light of our financial situation I will have to notify employees funded by the Consolidated Grant on Monday, February 15, 2010 to cease working effective Monday, February 22, 2010 unless an additional \$700,000 is released to DOE every pay period.

Attached is a list of programs as well as the number of employees and students that will be affected if funding is not available. I hope we can work together to prevent a disruption of instructional services and undue anxiety and hardship to employees that will be affected.

On behalf of our 31,600 students and 4000 employees, thank you for all the help you've given DOE.
