AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 9 OF PUBLIC LAW 30-25, RELATIVE TO THE EFFECTIVE DATE FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE INTERNATIONAL BUILDING CODE; AND TO ADD A NEW SECTION 11 TO PUBLIC LAW 30-25, RELATIVE TO THE ADOPTION OF THE CODES REFERENCED IN THE IBC.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- 2 Section 1. Legislative Intent. The adoption of the International Building
- 3 Code will require a transitional period during which the Department of Public
- 4 Works Building Permits and Inspection section must become familiar with the

- 1 code provisions which are different in application than the currently used Uniform
- 2 Building Code. In discussions with officials from the Department of Public Works
- 3 it was estimated that a one hundred eighty (180) day period would be sufficient
- 4 time for the transition. However, this adoption also means the Guam Fire
- 5 Department will have to become familiar with the differences in the application of
- 6 the International Building Code as it relates to fire protection systems and other
- 7 requirements it enforces. By changing to this new code, the Guam Fire
- 8 Department will have to migrate from the Uniform Fire Code to the International
- 9 Fire Code to ensure compatibility between codes. It is the intent of *I Liheslaturan*
- 10 Guåhan to minimize confusion over which building codes and fire codes are to be
- 11 followed when applicants are submitting their plans for review and approval.
- 12 Therefore, the effective date of the implementation of the International Building
- 13 Code shall be amended from December 14, 2009 to June 30, 2010.
- Section 2. Section 9 of Public Law 30-25 is amended to read:
- "Section 9. Effective Date. This Act shall be effective on June 30,
- 2010, after which a transitional period *shall* be instituted wherein either the
- UBC 94 or the IBC 09 standards shall be applicable, as designated by the
- applicant, for a period of no more than ninety (90) days for projects
- submitted during the transition period. Following completion of the
- transitional period, *only* the IBC 09 *shall* be applicable. "
- Section 3. A new Section 11 is *added* to Public Law 30-25 to read as
- 22 follows:
- 23 "Section 11. Adoption of Referenced Codes. Pursuant to the
- adoption of the IBC 2009, associated codes referenced in the IBC 09, and
- subsequent updates to the IBC 2009, are hereby adopted, subject to review
- and adoption of the PEALS Board. Specifically, but not limited to, the codes
- 27 listed in Sections 101.4.1 through 101.4.6 [International Fuel Gas Code,

International Mechanical Code, International Plumbing Code, International Property Maintenance Code, International Fire Code, International Energy Conservation Code] and referenced elsewhere in [the IBC 09] shall be considered part of the requirements of [the IBC 09] to the prescribed extent of each such reference".
