AN ACT TO AMEND §26104(c) AND (d) OF CHAPTER 26, TITLE 16, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO EXEMPTING TAXICABS FROM THE REQUIREMENT FOR A CHILD RESTRAINT SYSTEM, BOOSTER SEAT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- Section 1. §26104 (c) and (d) of Title 16, Guam Code Annotated, are
- 3 *amended* to read:

"(c) The inadequately restrained individual is a passenger of an emergency, passenger transport vehicle or taxicab. As used in this Section, *unless* the context otherwise requires:

- (1) Emergency vehicle means an on-duty official ambulance, official firefighting vehicle, official rescue vehicle, or official law enforcement vehicle;
- (2) Passenger transport vehicle means any vehicle operated to carry passengers en masse with: (A) gross vehicle weight rating of over ten thousand (10,000) pounds; (B) that is specified on the vehicle's federal certification label by the manufacturer as any type of bus; or (C) that is classified as a bus, or issued a bus license plate, by the Department of Revenue and Taxation;
- (3) Taxicab means any vehicle being licensed, operated or maintained for the transportation of persons for hire, compensation or profit, with a gross vehicle rating *under* ten thousand (10,000) pounds.
- (d) The vehicle being operated was manufactured before January 1, 1967."
