AN ACT TO ADD A NEW SUBSECTION (f) TO §84121 TITLE **OF CHAPTER** 84, 10, **GUAM** CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO THE RIGHTS OF **INDIVIDUALS** WITH **HEARING AND** SPEECH **DISABILITIES** TO **ACCESS EMERGENCY** 911 SERVICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- Section 1. A new Subsection (f) is added to §84121 of Chapter 84 of Title
- 3 10, Guam Code Annotated, to read as follows:
- 4 "(f) Access For Individuals With Hearing And Speech Disabilities.

1 **(1)** The Guam Fire Department's Emergency 911 Telephone Communications System shall be accessible to individuals with 2 hearing and speech disabilities. 3 The means for such accessibility shall primarily be 4 **(2)** mobile and landline telephones, but nothing herein shall be construed 5 as to limit the Guam Fire Department from providing access to the 6 7 Emergency 911 Telephone Communications System through other modes of communication. 8 9 (3) The Guam Fire Department is prohibited from charging additional fees to telecommunications companies and/or their 10 customers for the cost of providing such accessibility. Any costs 11 associated with the implementation of the mandates of this subsection 12 shall be funded through existing surcharges." 13 Section 2. Effective Date. The provisions of this Act shall be effective 14

thirty (30) days from the date of enactment.
