P.L. 25-03 GENERAL APPROPRIATIONS ACT OF 1999, § 1 of Chapter IV, adds subsection (c) to 22 GCA 9105 requiring all government of Guam employers to reimburse the Government of Guam Special Fund (FUND) for compensation paid by the FUND.

Guam Society of Certified Public Accountants

§ 9105(c) reads:

WILLIAM BISCHOFF, ESQ. Assistant Attorney General "All government of Guam Executive, Judicial and Legislative departments, agencies, instrumentalities, inclusive of semi-autonomous and autonomous agencies and any other government of Guam entities and public corporations, shall reimburse such sums as may be necessary from their actual operational appropriations for revenues into the Worker's Compensation Fund for any payment of compensation approved, pursuant to Chapter 9, Division 1 of Title 22 of the Guam Code Annotated, by the Worker's Compensation Commission for employees of their respective department or agency."

Further 22 GCA 9105(d) mandates the government of Guam employer to effectuate the reimbursement within ten (10) days. § 9105(d) reads:

"Reimbursements to the Worker's Compensation Fund. Reimbursements into the Worker's Compensation Fund pursuant to § 9105(c) of this Chapter shall be made within ten (10) days of each installment and for amounts equal to the amount paid to the employee(s) pursuant to

§ 9115 of Title 22 of the Guam Code Annotated, except when the Commissioner of the Worker's Compensation deems it advisable that an employer make a deposit prior to payment of compensation."

Hereto is a list of compensation payments paid to your employees or their qualified dependents from the effective date of P.L. 25-03 to date. These amounts are now due for reimbursement to the FUND. Please note that the Attachment reflects only non-medical FUND expenditures.

If no payment had been made, then there will be no Attachment. However, from hereon, a memorandum and an Attachment will be issued whenever funds have been expended to your employees or their qualified dependents.

Let me impress the importance of addressing your prospective funding liability under P.L. 25-03. Please note that the heretofore excluded medical related expenditures may prospectively be identified as reimbursable expenditures.
