WHEREAS, Public Law 26-66, places the rate making authority of the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority under the GMHA Board of Trustees; and

WHEREAS, the GMHA Board of Trustees has reviewed the Public Law 26-66; and

WHEREAS, a Public Hearing was held on September 3, 2010 and oral comments and written testimony have been solicited for the One Hundred Thirteen (113) new fees comprised of the following Hospital departments: Radiology, Pharmacy, Emergency Room and Operating Room; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees Finance & Audit Committee met on September 13, 2010, reviewed and recommended that the Board of Trustees approve the One Hundred thirteen (113) new fee items; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has reviewed the list of new fees and found the same to be in order; and

WHEREAS, the Hospital has realized Three Hundred Fifty-One Thousand Four Hundred Sixteen Dollars and Cents 93/100 (\$351,416.93) in revenues since the inception of the new fees in FY2010; now therefore be it,

RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees accepts and approves the recommendation of the Finance & Audit Committee and adopts the One Hundred Thirteen (113) new fee items, and be it further



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## MINUTES

In accordance with the Administrative Adjudication Law, a public hearing was held on Friday, September 3, 2010, at 9:30 a.m. in the GMHA Daniel L. Webb Conference Room, to solicit public opinion on the Hospital's 113 new fees.

Present were: (Refer to Exhibit 11 – Attendance Sheet).

Note: Copies of the Public Hearing Agenda (Refer to Exhibit 10) and the Listing of New Fees (Refer to Exhibit 3) were made available to all attendees.

Ms. Flores noted that it was 9:35 a.m., Friday, September 3, 2010 and we all gathered here for the public hearing, which was duly noted and publicized to start at 9:30 a.m., but we would give allotment of about ten (10) minutes for additional attendees from the public to find parking to attend this hearing. We would resume the hearing at 9:40 a.m.

### **I. Introduction**

Ms. Jane B. Flores introduced herself as the Presiding Public Hearing Officer for this public hearing. Our public hearing recorder was Ms. Candy Chan. She began conducting the public hearing at 9:40 a.m.

### **II. Opening Remarks**

On behalf of the GMHA Board of Trustees, the Hospital Administrator/CEO, and the GMHA employees, Ms. Flores welcomed the public for attending the public hearing. She then commenced presenting the purpose of the public hearing today.

### **III. Purpose of the Public Hearing**

The enactment of Public Law 26-66 in December 2001 removed the rate-setting jurisdiction from the PUC and gave it to the GMHA Board of Trustee: It was noted under:

10 GCA §80105 Hospital Rates

“(b) The Authority may establish interim fees for new, un-tariffed services, medication and supplies, without prior legislative approval and without

compliance with the Administrative Adjudication Law; provided, that: (1) the interim fees are consistent with the Authority's Net Revenue Enhancement Engagement Pricing Model, as prepared by Deloitte & Touche, dated February 7, 1992, or such other protocol as may be approved by the Board of Trustees; and (2) a petition for permanent approval of the interim fees is filed by the Authority with I Liheslaturan Guahan within three (3) months of the Authority's establishment of the interim fee."

Ms. Flores indicated that the Hospital had a total of twenty-eight (28) public hearings during fiscal years 2002 through 2010. A total of 3,559 new fees/services and 2,181 rate increased fees had been introduced and adjudicated.

In compliance with the Administrative Adjudication Law and further Guam Code Annotated directives, the Hospital did publish in the Pacific Daily News and Marianas Variety the announcement of this public hearing (Refer to Exhibit 5 – Notice of Public Hearing) and distributed the Notice of Public Hearing to all Hospital departments and units and also posted in public areas throughout the Hospital.

The Hospital also sent the Notice of this Public Hearing via facsimiles to various news media organizations, the Governor's Office, the Congressional Representative, and to our elected Senators of the 30<sup>th</sup> Guam Legislature (Refer to Exhibit 6 – GMHA Fax Confirmations of Notifications). In addition, letters were also sent to the Third Party Payers inviting them to this public hearing with the listing of new fees attached (Refer to Exhibit 7 – Letters inviting Third Party Payers to Public Hearing).

The Hospital also posted the Notice of Public Hearing on its official website as mandated by public law and the website is [www.gmha.org](http://www.gmha.org) (Refer to Exhibit 9 – Press Release displayed on GMHA website).

At this time, Ms. Flores would like to introduce Mr. Luis Miclat who would do the presentation of the new fees today.

**IV. Presentation of Summary of New Fee Items**

Mr. Luis Miclat introduced himself being in charge of the Charge Master Library. He stated that we were presenting today a total of one hundred thirteen (113) new fee items submitted by various departments of the Hospital for the past three months. The summary of these new fee items/services were as follows:

Departments	Fee Item	Description
Radiology	63	Supplies and Procedures
Pharmacy	16	Pharmaceutical items
Emergency Room	28	Supplies and Services
Operating Room	6	Supplies
<b>TOTAL:</b>	<b>113</b>	Fee Items



## V. Testimonies from the Public

At this juncture of the public hearing, Ms. Flores referred to any individuals who came to this hearing and signed up for testimony of any concerns or interest they would like to present on the new fees. It was noted for the record that there were no attendees from the public. She informed that the public could submit a written testimony within five (5) days after this public hearing. These testimonies would be incorporated into the submission package to the 30th Guam Legislature, subsequent to the approval by the GMHA Board of Trustees.

## VI. Questions and Answers on the Proposed New Rates, Fees and Charges and Existing Fee Schedule

At this time, Ms. Flores stated that she would like to open up to the general public if there is any questions concerning the 113 new fee items presented today at this public hearing. It was noted that there were no questions from the general public present at this public hearing.

## VII. Closing Remarks



Ms. Flores called the hearing to adjourn at 9:46 a.m., September 3, 2010.





## Obama's goal: Win the Mideast peace

WASHINGTON (AP)—Firmly and finally ending the U.S. combat mission in Iraq, President Barack Obama will have but a moment before trying to hasten peace nearby between Israelis and Palestinians. Left unclear is whether winding down the war that inflamed Arab passions will do anything to help long-shot Mideast talks.

From the Oval Office, a setting designed to command gravity and attention, Obama will declare that Iraqis are now the ones in charge of a war he had opposed. He will be immersed in talks with Israeli and Palestinian leaders, underscoring the hopeful but precarious U.S. role as a middleman.

The White House is framing the two events as commitments kept by the president. But there is little excitement buzz and certainly no bold promises that capping the combat mission in Iraq will prod broader peace in the Middle East.

Tuesday night, Obama's emphasis will be to thank the troops and explain why the fight goes on in Afghanistan and beyond — and not so much about the potential for Iraq to be “a beacon of liberty in the Middle East” as President George W. Bush put it.

In a narrow sense, the peace talks convened by the White House have little to do with Iraq. The Middle East stalemate has to do with the borders of a potential Palestinian state, the fate of Palestinian refugees, the status

of Jerusalem, the security of Israel — and trust on both sides. Making progress on those points, not the Iraq war, is at the core of renewed talks between Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu and Palestinian President Mahmoud Abbas.

Writ large, however, the fate of Iraq is indeed tied to prospects for peace for its neighbors in the region.

“There is no direct connection between the two issues, but I think together they tell the same story: the limits of U.S. power,” said Marina Ottaway, director of the Middle East Program at the Carnegie Endowment for International Peace. “The U.S. can only go so far, and then it's in the hands of the regional actors.”

Much depends on whether Iraq's leaders can form a lasting government, whether

Iran will seek to exert added influence with a smaller U.S. presence in Iraq, and whether the United States will be perceived as the country that responsibly turned power back to Iraq or the one that left before the job was done.

“The more that Iraq emerges as a stable state after the Americans withdraw, the greater the chance for progress in the Middle East, the more it creates a stable environment for the peace process to move forward,” said

Robert Danin, an expert on Israeli-Palestinian

affairs and senior fellow at the Council on Foreign Relations. “To the extent that there's bloodshed and instability in Iraq, that makes it harder for people to focus on peacemaking.”

For now, a presidential speech about the changing of the U.S. mission in Iraq is as close to closure as the people of the United States will get.

All troops will not come home until the end of 2011 at the latest. The United States will still keep tens of thousands in a dangerous Iraq for support and counterterrorism missions in the meantime. More Americans are likely to die. As Obama has said: “We have not seen the end of American sacrifice in Iraq.”

Most of the more than 4,400 U.S. military members who have died in the Iraq war have been killed since May 2003 — after Bush declared the major combat operations over from the deck of a warship. His back-dropped then was a now infamous banner that declared “mission accomplished.”

“You won't hear those words coming from us,” Obama spokesman Robert Gibbs said Monday.

The United States, too, is still absorbed with the a widening war in Afghanistan, the base for the al-Qaida terrorists responsible for the Sept. 11 terrorist attacks.



## Nation Briefs

### Suspicious luggage found in UAL plane

WASHINGTON (AP) — Two men on a United Airlines flight from Chicago to Amsterdam were questioned by Dutch authorities after U.S. officials found a cell phone taped to a Pepto Bismol bottle and a knife and box cutter in checked luggage connected with the men, a law enforcement official said.

The official identified the men as Ahmed Mohamed Nasser al Soofi and Hezam al Murisi. Al Soofi had a Michigan address, the official said, but it was not immediately clear where the two men were from.

As of Monday night, FBI agents had visited the southwest Detroit neighborhood where several addresses were found for variations of al Soofi's name, according to neighbors who declined to give their names to The Associated Press.

ABC News, which first reported the incident Monday, said al Soofi was from Detroit and that both he and al Murisi were charged in the Netherlands with “preparation of a terrorist attack,” but U.S. officials would not confirm that.

5 GCA § 10306 (2004)

§ 10306. Information Required on Official Home Pages.

The following information is required to be posted on each Official Home Page for each Branch of the government of Guam:

Notice of Meetings and Public Hearings. Notice of all public meetings, public hearings and other public events for which notice is required under the provisions of Public Law, or applicable rules and regulations, shall be posted on the applicable Official Home Page by the minimum period of notice required for such meetings.
