Hafa adai, Ms. Duenas. This is to request for your assistance and approval of the attached request for appropriation/allotment modification.

Pursuant to the May 2010 Mid-period FY2010 Budget Review, the DMHSA submitted and concurred with BBMR on the operational and staffing needs for the remainder of the fiscal year. Due to requests outside of the mutually agreed projection, the DMHSA has had to realign its requests to comply with the Federal Management Team's requirements and the Permanent Injunction ACIP. Most of those requests were projected for implementation in the FY2011 as budgeted.

Therefore, in line with the FY2010 budget restrictions with respect to the Governor's Transfer Authority, the attached has been prepared accordingly. The DMHSA's budget projection is attached. Due to the RTF and the DMHSA's deficient available funds to process for ongoing and continuing required group home services, this modification is crucial for compliance with court orders for timely payment of services. The U.S. District Court has not lifted its order to report monthly on DMHSA's payment status of its service providers.
