There are several statutes requiring monthly reports of revenues in addition to a report requiring both revenue and expenditure comparisons. However, it is submitted to meet compliance with each reporting mandate. It is important to note that the Department of Administration, Department of Revenue and Taxation and the Bureau of Budget and Management Research are continuing their efforts to improve the format, content and usefulness of this report.
