AN ACT TO ADD A NEW §40143 TO CHAPTER 40 OF TITLE 5, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO PLACING THE FORMER F.Q. SANCHEZ ELEMENTARY SCHOOL FACILITY UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE UMATAC MAYOR'S OFFICE.

### 1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- Section 1. A new §40143 is added to Chapter 40 of Title 5, Guam Code
- 3 Annotated, to read as follows:
- 4 "§ 40143. Transfer of F.Q. Sanchez Elementary School Facility.

- 1 The land and buildings that comprise the former F.Q. Sanchez (a) 2 Elementary School in the village of Umatac is transferred to the 3 administrative jurisdiction of the *Umatac* Mayor's office. The facility may be used for any of the following purposes: 4 (b) 5 (1) Mayor's office; 6 Municipal Planning Council office; (2)7 (3) youth center or for recreational youth activities; 8 senior citizens center: (4) 9 healthcare facility; and (5) 10 educational facility. (6) 11 (c) The *Umatac* Municipal Planning Council is authorized to lease 12 portions of the facility, pursuant to §60114, Chapter 60 of Title 21, Guam 13 Code Annotated, relative to the leasing of government properties, to for-14 profit or not-for-profit entities to carry out the purposes of Subsection (b) of 15 this Section. 16 (d) All revenues derived from the leasing or other activities generated from the use of the facility shall be deposited in the Umatac 17 18 Municipal Planning Council Fund for the maintenance of the facility and for village activities or improvements. 19 20 The Umatac Mayor may enter into a memorandum of (e) 21 understanding with the Department of Administration for the management of 22 accounts related to the activities of this Section. Administrative fees to the 23 Department of Administration shall not exceed two percent (2%) of the
  - (f) The financial operations of the facility *shall* be subject to audit/review by the Office of Public Accountability.

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revenues.

(g) All uses, renovations and improvements to the facility *shall* comply with federal historic preservation laws and regulations applicable to Guam, and with Chapter 76 of Title 21, Guam Code Annotated.

(h) In the event that the *Umatac* Municipal Planning Council determines in the future that they no longer have a need for the facility, title to the facility *shall* revert to the *Chamorro* Land Trust Commission and be added to the available lands inventory of the *Chamorro* Land Trust Commission."
