AN ACT TO *ADD* A NEW §5132 TO PART D OF ARTICLE 2, CHAPTER 5 OF TITLE 5, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO THE RETENTION OF PROCUREMENT-RELATED ELECTRONIC MAIL (EMAIL) CORRESPONDENCES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. A new §5132 is *added* to Part D of Article 2, Chapter 5 of Title 5,
Guam Code Annotated, to read as follows:

4 "§ **5132. Retention of Electronic Mail Correspondences.** All 5 incoming and outgoing electronic mail (email) correspondences pertaining to 6 matters related to the procurement of goods and services as governed by this

Chapter *shall* be retained for a period of *not less than* five (5) years. Such
 electronic mail (email) correspondences may be used for evidentiary purposes in
 the appellate procedures contained in this Chapter."
