MEETING MINUTES

Regular Board Meeting of February 18, 2013

I. Call to Order

The meeting was called to order by Vice-Chairman Manuel Cruz at 4:34 pm, at the GRTA conference room, Administration Building, Hagatna.

II. Roll Call

III. Approval of Minutes

V. Old Business

1. Recruitment of Executive Manager

2. Update of the Veterans Transportation and Community Living "One Call, One Click" Center

G. Porter reported that she has completed a draft form of the RFP (Request for Proposal) for the Transportation Management Software. There are two versions that the staff and board will need to make a decision on which one to use.

G. Porter stated that when she was in Saipan she met with Mr. Tom Camacho and asked where they were with the VTCLI Grant. G. Porter stated that T. Camacho mentioned that he was interested in procuring a Transportation Management Software for their One Call/One Click Center.

G. Porter stated that T. Camacho also mentioned that they will be purchasing four (4) busses. G. Porter stated that GRTA would be willing to share the bus procurement specifications if they were interested in piggy-backing with GRTA when we procure the busses.

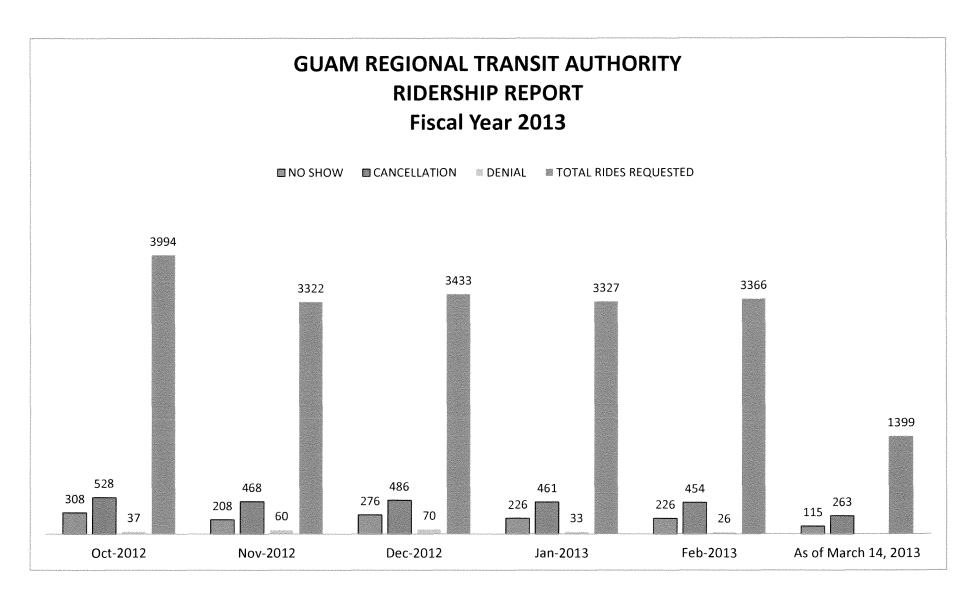
