This matter came before the Civil Service Commission on March 26, 2013 for hearing under the provisions of the Public Employee Protection Act (the "Act") codified in 4 G.C.A. § 4501 *et seq.* After having reviewed the submissions of the employee, Joey Cruz, in this matter and hearing the presentation of an assessment by Maria Masnayan, Personnel Management Analyst III, it is the finding of the Commission that Mr. Cruz did not engage in a disclosure of information pursuant to 4 G.C.A. §4502(c) which would enable him to invoke the protections offered by the Act. This matter is therefore dismissed.






