2 Section 1. A new Sub-item (1) is *added* to § 61103(q) of Article 1, Title

1 "(1) Bed and Breakfast. A private residence or building appurtenant 2 or accessory to a private residence containing five or fewer rooms intended 3 or designed to be used, or which are used, rented, or hired out to be 4 occupied, or which are occupied for sleeping purposes. No home may be licensed as a Bed and Breakfast whose physical address is the physical 5 6 address of a registered sex offender." 7 Section 2. § 61305(a) of Article 3, Title 21, Guam Code Annotated, is 8 hereby amended to read: 9 **R1 One-Family Dwelling Zone.** "§ 61305. 10 (a) Use Permitted. 11 (1)One-family dwellings. 12 (2)Gardening and the keeping of pets for noncommercial 13 purposes. 14 Bed and breakfasts. (3)Use customarily accessory to any of the above uses, 15 (4)16 including home occupations and private parking areas with accessory 17 buildings and structures." 18 Section 3. § 61306(a) of Article 3, Title 21, Guam Code Annotated, is 19 hereby *amended* to read: 20"§ 61306. **R2** Multiple Dwelling Zone. 21Use Permitted. (a) 22 (1)One-family dwellings. 23 (2)Duplexes. 24 (3)Multi-family dwellings. Hotels, private groups, and institutions. 25 (4)26 Bed and breakfasts. (5)

1 Accessory uses and structures for the above." (6)2 § 61307(b)(6) of Article 3, Title 21, Guam Code Annotated, is Section 4. 3 hereby *amended* to read: 4 "(6) Hotels, motels. bed and breakfasts, and tourist 5 accommodations." 6 Section 5. The first paragraph of § 30101 of Chapter 30, Division 2 of Title 7 11, Guam Code Annotated, is *amended* to read: 8 "§ 30101. Imposition. 9 An excise tax is hereby levied and imposed which shall be assessed 10 and collected monthly, against transient occupants of a room or rooms in a hotel, lodging house, and bed and breakfast, or similar facility located in 11 12 Guam according to the following schedule:" § 30102(a) of Chapter 30, Division 2 of Title 11, Guam Code 13 Section 6. 14 Annotated, is *amended* to read: 15 Transient occupant of a room or rooms in a hotel, lodging house, and "(a) bed and breakfast facility or similar facilities" means those persons who occupy 16 such facilities in a specific location for less than ninety consecutive days." 17
