AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF ONE (\$100,000)HUNDRED **THOUSAND DOLLARS** ESCHEATED TO THE GENERAL FUND, PURSUANT TO §21116 OF CHAPTER 21, DIVISION 2, TITLE 5, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, TO THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE AND TAXATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUPPORTING THE OBJECTIVES OF P.L. 31-135. **ECONOMY** ALSO KNOWN AS THE "CASH ENFORCEMENT ACT OF 2011".

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- 2 Section 1. Appropriation. Notwithstanding any other provision of law,
- 3 the sum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000) escheated to the General
- 4 Fund at the end of Fiscal Year 2012 and available for appropriations in Fiscal Year

- 1 2013, pursuant to §21116 of Chapter 21, Division 2, Title 5, Guam Code
- 2 Annotated, is hereby appropriated to the Department of Revenue and Taxation for
- 3 the purpose of supporting the objectives of P.L. 31-135, also known as the "Cash
- 4 Economy Enforcement Act of 2011". Such funds shall be deposited into the "Better
- 5 Public Service Fund" administered by the Department of Revenue and Taxation.
- 6 Section 2. Unused Appropriation. Funds not expended pursuant to
- 7 Section 1 of this Act within one year following the date of enactment, shall no
- 8 longer be available to the Department of Revenue and Taxation, and shall become
- 9 available for future appropriations by *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*.
- 10 Section 3. Reporting Requirement. The Director of the Department of
- 11 Revenue and Taxation shall submit a report to I Maga'lahen Guåhan and I
- 12 Liheslaturan Guåhan on a monthly basis as to the obligation and expenditure of
- 13 the funds and the status of its implementation following the enactment of this Act,
- detailing all transactions pertaining to the funds appropriated herein.
- 15 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Act *shall* be effective upon enactment.
