

AN ACT TO AMEND SUBSECTION II. AG. OF SECTION 2 OF CHAPTER I, AND TO ADD A NEW SECTION 17 TO CHAPTER X, BOTH OF PUBLIC LAW 31-233 (GENERAL APPROPRIATIONS ACT OF 2013), RELATIVE TO MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FROM THE TOURIST ATTRACTION FUND (TAF) TO THE GUAM VISITORS BUREAU (GVB) FOR THE HURÅO ACADEMY, INC. TO CONTINUE ITS MISSION IN PROMOTING AND PERPETUATING THE CHAMORU LANGUAGE AND CULTURE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

1 Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds 2 that the *Chamoru* language and culture has been and is under immediate threat of 3 extinction, and that the only "proficient" speakers of the *Chamoru* language are 4 now 50 years and older. Furthermore, with the average life expectancy of Guam's 5 *Chamoru* people at 65 to 70 years, it is conceivable that the language will be 6 extinct by 2025.

I Liheslaturan Guåhan further finds that the *Huråo* Academy, Inc., established in 2005, is a non-profit organization that was created in an effort to address the need for a "stable" and "successful" *Chamoru* language program on Guam. Additionally, Huråo Academy, Inc. is the first "full-immersion" *Chamoru* language program to meet the needs of a community struggling to preserve their language.

I Liheslaturan Guåhan further finds that the Huråo Academy has grown its language immersion program serving over four thousand students. Furthermore, the Huråo Academy also added parent, adult and corporate class programs serving over two thousand students, parents, and adults in the community-at-large, and have begun cultural apprenticeship classes in blacksmithing and weaving, providing translation services, *ChagiChamoru*, a television language program, and a cultural preservation program.

20 I Liheslaturan Guåhan further finds that revenue estimates for the Tourist Attraction Fund (TAF) for Fiscal Year 2013 are tracking at Twenty-Six Million 21 22 Five Hundred Seven Thousand Three Hundred Twenty-nine Dollars (\$26,507,329), of which Twenty-three Million Eight Hundred Eighty-eighty 23 Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (\$23,888,200) is appropriated. 24

I Liheslaturan Guåhan further finds that the TAF revenues for Fiscal Year
 2013 are projected to exceed appropriations by One Million Seven Hundred Eight
 Thousand Four Hundred Eighty-eight Dollars (\$1,708,488), in addition to the

Fiscal Year 2012 ending cumulative fund balance of Four Million Sixty-five
 Thousand Fifteen Dollars (\$4,065,015), and is available for appropriation.

3 I Liheslaturan Guåhan further finds that the Huråo Academy, Inc. has been 4 the only organization on Guam who has consistently provided *Chamoru* Language 5 Immersion programs to the community since 2005, and in the effort to increase the 6 number of native language speakers on Guam, it is the intent of I Liheslaturan Guåhan to support the Hurao Academy, Inc. to continue their mission to promote 7 8 and perpetuate the *Chamoru* language and culture for the past, present, and future 9 generations of children through the implementation of immersion community programs, the development of educational materials, and any other related areas 10 11 that support this mission.

Section 2. Subsection II. AG. (Tourist Attraction Fund) of Section 2
(Estimated Revenues for Fiscal Year 2013) of Chapter I (General Provisions) of
Public Law 31-233 is hereby *amended* to read:

"AG. Tourist Attraction Fund

\$26,507,329"

Section 3. A new Section 17 is hereby *added* to Chapter X (Guam Visitors
Bureau) of Public Law 31-233 to read:

18 "Section 17. Appropriation to GVB for Huråo Academy, 19 Inc. The sum of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000) is hereby appropriated 20from the Tourist Attraction Fund (TAF) to the Guam Visitors Bureau for 21 Huråo Academy, Inc. for the purposes of providing funding to cover all 22 costs directly associated with the operations and administration of the Huråo 23 Academy to promote and perpetuate the *Chamoru* language and culture. 24 Notwithstanding the general provisions of §30107.1 of Chapter 30, Title 11 25 GCA, and this Act, this appropriation *shall* continue to be available until 26expended. The provisions contained in Section 14 (Service and Reporting 27 Requirements) of Chapter X of Public Law 31-233 shall be applicable."
