Dear Governor Calvo:

Pursuant to 4 GCA §4301(a), *I Maga'lahi* is authorized to enter into contracts and reject proposals with the written concurrence of the *I Liheslaturan Guahan* or of the Judicial Branch. Please be advised that the Judicial Branch has elected to enter into a separate group health insurance contract for its employees as authorized by 4 GCA §4301(c). Accordingly, the Judicial Branch does not concur and withholds its consent to *I Maga'lahi Guahan* to enter into contracts with insurance companies authorized to do business in Guam for group insurance, including hospitalization, medical care and accident to include the Judiciary of Guam.

Since the Judicial Branch has elected to enter into a separate contract for its employees, the Governor must obtain the written concurrence of the Judicial Branch before the Governor can enter into a contract for group health insurance to include the employees of the Judicial Branch.
