A RESOLUTION

Conveying the gratitude of the leadership of Pohnpei and its people to the great leadership of the island of Guam and its good people for recognizing the importance of the Pohnpei Liberation Day and for assisting the people of Pohnpei now residing on the island of Guam in preparing for the celebration of this important holiday.

1 **WHEREAS**, the island of Pohnpei, along with other Pacific
2 islands that now form the Federated States of Micronesia, suffered
3 greatly during the conflicts of World War II in which many islanders lost
4 their lives, their livelihoods and their properties; and

5 **WHEREAS**, in 1945, these hostilities came to an end at the
6 conclusion of World War II resulting in a joyous liberation for the island
7 of Pohnpei; and

8 **WHEREAS**, upon their liberation from the aggressions of World
9 War II, the people of Pohnpei have not forgotten the joy of obtaining their
10 freedom and have from then until now celebrated this joyous holiday; and

11 **WHEREAS**, the people of Pohnpei through their continued
12 celebration of their valuable freedom have designated a holiday or a day
13 of remembrance, September 11, that is filled with enthusiastic
14 traditional, cultural, and sporting activities; and

15 **WHEREAS**, the leadership of Pohnpei have discovered the
16 kindness of the great leadership of the island of Guam and its good
17 people in recognizing and assisting the people of Pohnpei now residing
18 on the island of Guam in their preparation of the Pohnpei Liberation Day
19 celebrations in Guam; and

20 **WHEREAS**, the leadership of Pohnpei and its people are
21 immensely grateful to the great leadership of the island of Guam and its
22 good people for recognizing this joyous day; now, therefore,


23 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Eighth Pohnpei Legislature,
24 Fourteenth Special Session, 2013, that this Legislative Assembly, for
25 and on behalf of the people of Pohnpei, hereby convey the gratitude of


1 the leadership of Pohnpei and its people to the great leadership of the

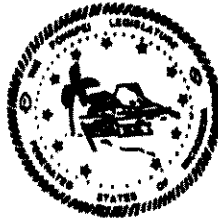


