Report on Election Process and Results for the District Directors

Northern and Southern Soil and Water Conservation District Boards

As per the University of Guam promulgated Election Rules pertaining to the Directors, Northern and Southern Soil and Water Conservation District Boards (SWCDBs) and authorized by Chapter 71, Title 5 of the Guam Code Annotated, the College of Natural and Applied Sciences conducted, for the University, the triennial election of District Directors for the Northern and Southern districts on Tuesday, August 20, 2013 between the hours of 8:00AM and 7:00PM in Conference Room 104, ALS Building, UOG campus. The election held was to fill anew the required composition of five (5) director nonpartisan positions for each district board, Northern and Southern, which are elected every three (3) years.

The initial call for nominations and announcement of the 2013 Election was sent out via paid advertisement on the July 15, 2013 issue of the Guam PDN as well as through Public Service Announcements at various Guam media outlets. As a result, a total of three (3) official nominations for the Northern District and four (4) official nominations for the Southern District were received by the deadline of 12 Noon, August 2, 2013. The nominations were as followed:

NORTHERN DISTRICT: Gregory Ontar Cefre, Hope A. Cristobal and Joseph Cruz Santos.

SOUTHERN DISTRICT: Lorenzo "Larry" B. Flores, Brian F. Leon Guerrero, William "Bill" C. McDonald and Angelita "Angie" P. Mendiola.

The announcement for election was sent out via paid advertisements on the August 16, 2013 and August 19 and 20, 2013 issues of the Guam PDN. On the day of election (Tuesday, August 20, 2013) a total of Seventy-three (73) voters cast ballots for the Northern District, and a total Fifty-six (56) voters cast ballots for the Southern District.

On post-election day (Wednesday, August 21, 2013), the tabulation of the election results proceeded at 9:00AM in Conference Room 202, ALS Building, UOG campus. As per Election Rules, the requisite sorting and tallying of votes cast were conducted by University officials including: Victor T. Artero, UOG Cooperative Extension Service, Jesse B. Rosario, CNAS Program Coordinator IV, and Annie F. Santos, CNAS Administrative Assistant. The two witnesses for each district included: Mr. Roland J. Quitugua and Ms. Alison Hadley for the Northern District, and Mr. William C. McDonald and Ms. Peggy Denny for the Southern District.

The counting of the ballots for the Northern District indicated that aside from the Three (3) candidate nominees listed on the ballot, a total of Fifteen (15) write-in candidates were accounted. The counting of the ballots for the Southern District indicated that aside from the Four (4) candidate nominees listed on the ballot, a total of eight (8) write-in candidates were accounted. The tally of the votes counted for both the Northern District and Southern District follows:

The above indicates that all nominees were successful in their election bid. As a matter of record, the above successful WRITE-IN elected candidates (two from the Northern and one from the Southern districts) were contacted to ascertain their affirmation of acceptance to serve and all responded positively.

For your information, all documents such as nomination forms, Voter Registry and Voter Eligibility Forms for those are not on the Registry, ballots and tabulations are available for review and will be kept in my office for a period of sixty calendar days before they are destroyed. This report will be kept indefinitely for historical purposes.

In closing, please find attached, for your use and as required by law, a certification of the election results which is also required to be transmitted to the Governor and the Legislature.
