

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF SEVEN HUNDRED **THOUSAND DOLLARS** (\$700,000)ESCHEATED TO THE GENERAL FUND, PURSUANT TO §21116 OF CHAPTER 21, DIVISION 2, TITLE 5, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, TO THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION FOR THE **PURPOSE FUNDING** THE ACQUISITION OF SOFTWARE, MIGRATION, FIBER CONNECTION SECURITY, AND OTHER UPGRADES NECESSARY TO SUPPORT AND PROTECT THE GOVERNMENT OF **GUAM'S COMPUTER** SYSTEM AND NETWORK INFRASTRUCTURE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- 1 Section 1. Appropriation. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, 2 the sum of Seven Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$700,000) escheated to the General 3 Fund prior to the end of Fiscal Year 2013, and is available for appropriations in Fiscal Year 2013 and Fiscal Year 2014, pursuant to §21116 of Chapter 21, 4 5 Division 2, Title 5, Guam Code Annotated, is hereby appropriated to the 6 Department of Administration for the acquisition of software, migration, fiber 7 connection security, government-wide active directory, and upgrades for the 8 government of Guam's computer system and network infrastructure, and related 9 purposes.
- Section 2. Unused Appropriation. Funds *not* obligated pursuant to the provisions of this Act, within one year following the date of enactment, *shall no longer* be available to the Department of Administration. Such funds *shall* become available for future appropriations by *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*.
- Section 3. Reporting Requirement. The Director of the Department of
 Administration shall submit a report to I Maga'lahen Guåhan and I Liheslaturan
 Guåhan on a quarterly basis as to the obligation and expenditures of the funds
 following the enactment of this Act, detailing all transactions pertaining to funds
 appropriated herein.
- 19 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Act *shall* be effective upon enactment.
