



AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF FOUR HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$400,000) ESCHEATED TO THE GENERAL FUND, PURSUANT TO §21116 OF CHAPTER 21, DIVISION 2, TITLE 5, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, TO THE GUAM POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR THE PURCHASE OF NEW POLICE VEHICLES.

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Appropriation.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law,
3 the sum of Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$400,000) escheated to the General
4 Fund prior to the end of Fiscal Year 2013, and is available for appropriations in

1 Fiscal Year 2013 and Fiscal Year 2014, pursuant to §21116 of Chapter 21,
2 Division 2, Title 5, Guam Code Annotated, is hereby appropriated to the Guam
3 Police Department for the purchase of new completely marked police vehicles,
4 which *shall* include, but *not* be limited to, graphics, emergency lighting, siren,
5 police/radio communication system, and a prisoner transport system. The purchase
6 of police vehicles *shall* include a vehicle warranty and maintenance program.
7 Police vehicles must be purchased from the manufacturer's authorized dealer in
8 Guam, and the price *shall* include the manufacturer's full warranty and suggested
9 or recommended routine maintenance schedule, as defined by the manufacturer's
10 scheduled maintenance guide, for a minimum of three years or 125,000 miles,
11 whichever occurs first.

12 **Section 2. Unused Appropriation.** Funds *not* obligated pursuant to the
13 provisions of this Act, within one year following the date of enactment, *shall no*
14 *longer* be available to the Guam Police Department. Such funds *shall* become
15 available for future appropriations by *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*.

16 **Section 3. Reporting Requirement.** The Chief of Police *shall* submit a
17 report to *I Maga'lahaen Guåhan* and *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* on a quarterly basis as
18 to the obligation and expenditures of the funds following the enactment of this Act,
19 detailing all transactions pertaining to funds appropriated herein.

20 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Act *shall* be effective upon enactment.
