AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF FOUR HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$400,000) ESCHEATED TO THE GENERAL FUND, PURSUANT TO \$21116 OF CHAPTER 21, DIVISION 2, TITLE 5, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, TO THE GUAM POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR THE PURCHASE OF NEW POLICE VEHICLES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- 2 Section 1. Appropriation. Notwithstanding any other provision of law,
- 3 the sum of Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$400,000) escheated to the General
- 4 Fund prior to the end of Fiscal Year 2013, and is available for appropriations in

- 1 Fiscal Year 2013 and Fiscal Year 2014, pursuant to §21116 of Chapter 21,
- 2 Division 2, Title 5, Guam Code Annotated, is hereby appropriated to the Guam
- 3 Police Department for the purchase of new completely marked police vehicles,
- 4 which shall include, but not be limited to, graphics, emergency lighting, siren,
- 5 police/radio communication system, and a prisoner transport system. The purchase
- 6 of police vehicles shall include a vehicle warranty and maintenance program.
- 7 Police vehicles must be purchased from the manufacturer's authorized dealer in
- 8 Guam, and the price shall include the manufacturer's full warranty and suggested
- 9 or recommended routine maintenance schedule, as defined by the manufacturer's
- scheduled maintenance guide, for a minimum of three years or 125,000 miles,
- 11 whichever occurs first.
- 12 Section 2. Unused Appropriation. Funds not obligated pursuant to the
- 13 provisions of this Act, within one year following the date of enactment, shall no
- 14 longer be available to the Guam Police Department. Such funds shall become
- 15 available for future appropriations by I Liheslaturan Guåhan.
- 16 Section 3. Reporting Requirement. The Chief of Police shall submit a
- 17 report to I Maga'lahen Guåhan and I Liheslaturan Guåhan on a quarterly basis as
- 18 to the obligation and expenditures of the funds following the enactment of this Act,
- 19 detailing all transactions pertaining to funds appropriated herein.
- 20 **Section 4.** Effective Date. This Act *shall* be effective upon enactment.
