This matter came before the Civil Service Commission for a determination of whether to pursue further investigation into allegations by Kevin R. Guerrero that he was retaliated against by Guam Police Department management. Maria Masnayon, the Commission's Personnel Management Analyst III, presented an assessment and recommended that the Commission undertake an investigation under its authority found in 4 G.C.A. §4504(a). Management of the Guam Police Department was also present and represented by Assistant Attorney General Fred Nishihira. In light of Guerrero's pending adverse action appeal, the underlying basis of which relates directly to the issues presented here, the Commission hereby orders that this matter be stayed until the final resolution of Guerrero's adverse action appeal, *Guerrero v. Guam Police Dep't.*, Adverse Action Appeal Case No. 13-AA25S.




