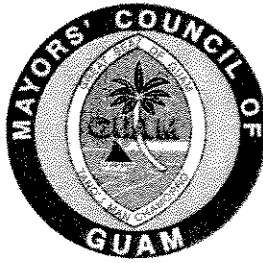

RELATIVE TO THE MAYORS' COUNCIL OF GUAM SUPPORTING BILL NO. 78-32 AN ACT TO ADD SUBSECTION (D) TO §3102.3 CHAPTER 3 OF 17 GUAM CODE ANNOTATED RELATIVE TO THE COMPOSITION OF THE GUAM EDUCATION BOARD TO INCLUDE A REPRESENTATIVE FROM THE MAYORS' COUNCIL OF GUAM.

1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY KONSEHELON MAHOT GUÅHAN:**

2 **WHEREAS**, during the 26th Guam Legislature it was found that the Guam
3 Education Policy Board should have a voting representative from the Mayors' Council
4 of Guam and legislation was subsequently passed which became law known as Public
5 Law 26-26; and

6 **WHEREAS**, the 31st Guam Legislature introduced legislation which made several
7 changes to Chapter 3 of Title 17 of the Guam Code Annotated including the removal the
8 Mayors' Council of Guam as a member which later became Public Law 31-19 ; and

9 **WHEREAS**, the Mayors' Council of Guam have always played an active role to
10 Guam's Education by providing logistical support, traffic safety, family assistance,
11 verifications, general maintenance, recreation, and in some instances the usage of
12 community facilities; and

13 **WHEREAS**, it has been found that now more than ever it takes a community to
14 raise a child and that Mayors' Offices have become the front lines for Health, Safety and
15 Education for families; and

16 **WHEREAS**, the development of this mutual partnership and relationship will be
17 beneficial to each community that it serves offering accountability, a better use of
18 resources, and transparency; and

19 **WHEREAS**, by restoring the position AND ADDING the privilege to vote, it would
20 cause the board of education to be more responsive to the communities needs, offer
21 consistency and respect from the school leaders to the respective Mayors and Vice
22 Mayors and provide for better communication and cooperation in that respective school
23 district; *now therefore be it*

1 **RESOLVED**, that the Mayors' Council of Guam, does hereby, on behalf of the
2 people of Guam, support Bill No. 78-32 (*With our suggested amendment*) An act to *add*
3 subsection (d) to §3102.3 Chapter 3 of 17 Guam Code Annotated relative to the
4 composition of the Guam Education Board to include a representative from the Mayors'
5 Council of Guam; and it be further

6 **RESOLVED**, that the President certify to and the Council Secretary attests the
7 adoption hereof, and that copies of the same be thereafter transmitted to and that copies
8 of the same be thereafter transmitted to the Honorable Vicente c. pangelinan, Senator
9 and Bill Sponsor and Senators of the 32nd Guam Legislature and, to the Honorable
10 Edward J.B. Calvo, *I Maga'lahren Guåhan*.
