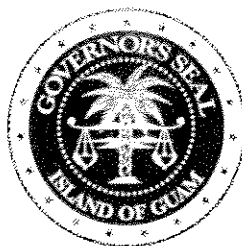



**AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 12 OF PUBLIC LAW 32-067,
RELATIVE TO THE WAIVER OF SOVEREIGN IMMUNITY
ON A LOAN PREVIOUSLY AUTHORIZED FOR I
LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN (THE GUAM LEGISLATURE).**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1.** Section 12 of Public Law 32-067 is hereby *amended* to read as
3 follows:

4 **“Section 12. Waiver of Sovereign Immunity.** Notwithstanding any
5 substantive or procedural provision of Chapter 6 of Title 5, Guam Code
6 Annotated, the government of Guam *shall not* be entitled to immunity from

1 any suit or action in contract on any indebtedness authorized hereby. For the
2 purposes of this provision *only*, immunity is also waived as to the award of
3 attorney fees and related costs in connection with any suit brought to enforce
4 any right or obligation incurred under the loan authorized hereby in
5 connection with the enforcement of any agreement, note or pledge that arises
6 directly from the indebtedness authorized hereby.”

7 **Section 2. Severability.** *If* any provision of this Act or its application to
8 any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such
9 invalidity *shall not* affect other provisions or applications of this Act which can be
10 given effect without the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the
11 provisions of this Act are severable.
