





**AN ACT TO *ADD* A NEW § 3219.1 TO ARTICLE 2,
CHAPTER 3 OF TITLE 17, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED,
RELATIVE TO AWARDING HONORARY HIGH
SCHOOL DIPLOMAS FOR CERTAIN SENIOR
CITIZENS.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1.** A new § 3219.1 is *added* to Article 2 of Chapter 3 of Title 17
3 Guam Code Annotated to read as follows:

4 “§ 3219.1. **Honorary High School Diplomas for Certain Senior**
5 **Citizens.**”

1 (a) The Guam Department of Education *shall* award an honorary
2 high school diploma to any current or former resident of Guam:

3 (1) who did *not* receive a high school diploma;

4 (2) who resided on Guam during World War II, from
5 December 7, 1941 to September 2, 1945;

6 (3) who would have been eligible to attend school, but
7 his/her education was interrupted with the occupation of Japanese
8 enemy forces; and

9 (4) who did *not* continue his/her education after World War
10 II in order to work and rebuild their homes and lives or assist in the
11 care of family members.

12 (b) The Guam Department of Education and the Mayors Council of
13 Guam *shall* work collaboratively to implement this Section.

14 (c) The Guam Department of Education may award diplomas
15 posthumously to those otherwise qualified under Subsection (a).”
