#### 1.0 CALL TO ORDER / ROLL CALL

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Michael Makio at 3:45 p.m., and roll call was conducted.

#### 2.0 ELECTION OF OFFICERS

Chairman Makio opened the floor for nominations for Vice Chair, Treasurer and Secretary for the Board of Directors. The Board reviewed the current officers.

#### 2.1. Vice – Chair

Helen Bordallo nominated Marilyn Salas for Vice Chair. With no further discussion or objections, Richard Olmo seconded the nomination. Nominations for Vice-Chair were closed.

#### 2.2. Treasurer

Chairman Makio entertained nominations for Treasurer.

Marilyn Salas nominated Helen Bordallo for Treasurer. With no further discussion or objections, Richard Olmo seconded the nomination.

Nominations for Treasurer were closed.

#### 2.3. Secretary

Chairman Makio entertained nominations for Secretary.

The Board discussed a Board member can serve as both Secretary and Treasurer. With no further discussion, Marilyn Salas amended her previous nomination, nominating Helen Bordallo as Secretary and Treasurer. With no further discussion or objections, Richard Olmo seconded the nomination.

#### Motion

With no further discussion, a motion was made to approve the nominations of Marilyn Salas as Vice-Chair, and Helen Bordallo as Secretary/Treasurer for the Guam Preservation Trust Board of Directors. The motion was unanimously approved.

### 3.0 EXECUTIVE SESSION

Chairman Makio recessed the General Board Meeting and entered into Executive Session.

Chairman Makio adjourned Executive Session and reconvened the General Board meeting.

### 4.0 APPROVAL OF MINUTES (12/18/13 Meeting)

Chairman Makio opened the floor for discussion on the Minutes of the December 18, 2013 Board Meeting.

The following corrections were noted:

Page 1, Item 3.1.; Delete "\$25,000.00" before National Park Service.

Page 1, Correct recent changes of disciplines as follows: Richard Olmo's, Archaeology – P; Rebecca Duenas, Chamorro Culture – P; Helen Bordallo, History – P.

Page 2; move placement of text down on 1st paragraph

Page 2; Item 5.2.; correct spelling to "Manenggon"

#### Motion

With no further changes or corrections, Marilyn Salas motioned to approve the minutes with the changes. The motion was seconded by Richard Olmo and unanimously approved.

#### 5.0 NEW BUSINESS

### 5.1. Plaza De España – Letter of Proposal

Michael Makio reported the Legislature will be soliciting for a management team for the Plaza de España. The team will be responsible for the repairs, maintenance, upkeep, and establishing visitor protocols for events and tours of the facility.

The management may be similar to the "Friends of the Arizona Memorial" in Hawaii.

Joe Quinata reported the Legislature wants to the newly rehabilitated facility well maintained and hoped that GPT would be able to assist.

An approval from the Board would be needed to draft a management proposal to the Legislature. The proposal may include an enterprise plan to hold functions, interpretive and education programs, and heritage tourism packages to produce revenue for the maintenance of the structure and grounds.

The Dept. of Chamorro Affairs (DCA) has also expressed interest in maintaining the site.

Lynda Aguon noted DCA's intent is to expand the museum grounds and to utilize the Plaza to house a gift shop, and further commented the Legislature may discuss turning the management responsibility to another agency or entity that can manage the facility. Chairman Makio recommended that the Dept. of Parks & Recreation may propose that directly with the Legislature.

The Board discussed the possibility to collaborate with different organizations interested in sharing the responsibility to maintain the site.

#### Motion

With no further discussion, Rebecca Duenas motioned to authorize staff to start the development of a plan, for discussion purposes, relative to the management of the Plaza de España. The motion was seconded by Richard Olmo and unanimously approved.

#### 6.0 OLD BUSINESS

#### 6.1. Strategic Plan 2013-17

Joe Quinata reported the results of the December 30<sup>th</sup> Strategic Plan Session was emailed to the Board. Board members Michael Makio, Rebecca Duenas, Richard Olmo, Helen Bordallo, and GPT staff, met to review and prioritize the programs and ideas recommended by the Stakeholders as part of the process towards producing the 2013-2017, Strategic Plan.

The Strategic Plan will serve as the guide for the goals of GPT for the next five (5) years and does not limit GPT from accomplishing other preservation programs.

A total of 95 stakeholders participated in five sessions encompassing the various preservation disciplines.

Upon the Board's approval of the proposed programs, the staff will further evaluate and provide the information on proposed collaborators, estimated costs, and funding sources to complete the goals.

#### Motion

With no further discussion, Helen Bordallo motioned to adopt the proposed outcomes from the strategic planning exercise and to authorize the staff to move ahead with designing of the priorities.

The motion was seconded by Richard Olmo and unanimously approved.

Chairman Makio remarked that the Strategic Plan is an evolving document and priorities may change over the year. The plan may be revisited at any point.

#### 7.0 COMMITTEE REPORTS

#### 7.1. BUDGET & FINANCE COMMITTEE

#### 7.1.a. YTD Balance

Chairman Makio reported the current fund is \$6,170,741.70. The total fund available for grants and projects is \$5,215,252.95.

A brief overview of the programs and grants was presented.

Staff was reminded of the Board action to terminate the Historic Inalahan grant and work with the organization to bring on the expertise to conduct a proper restoration on the facility.

The administration and operations expenditure report was reviewed.

### 7.2. ARCHITECTURE COMMITTEE

The Board referred to the Project Summary for Project updates.

### **Guam Legislature**

Chairman Makio reported up to \$3 million of GPT funds are targeted for the historic preservation component of the Legislature while the Legislature is projecting between \$2.5 to 3 million for their costs of the expansion wings. The Legislature is working through Bank of Guam & GEDA for the funding.

GPT has established a precedence to expedite the use of the funds for the grant programs and projects it is intended to accomplish.

GPT has waited over a year for the Legislature to secure its portion of the funding.

Nicole Santos reported Senator Rodriguez is introducing Bill 251 regarding the waiver of sovereign immunity for the Loan. The bill is currently in review and a Public Hearing is being scheduled.

Chairman Makio asked that the results of the Public Hearing and the Bill be included on the next Board agenda.

#### 7.3. GRANTS COMMITTEE

Joe Quinata referred the Board to review the Grants and Project Summary for Grant updates.

No new grants have been submitted but new submissions should be aligned with the grant programs of the Strategic Plan.

Grants that may require Board action for either termination or continuance will be presented at the next Board meeting

#### 8.0 OPEN DISCUSSION

- Lynda Aguon reported the Review Board will conduct its election at their next meeting.
  - If the Review Board selects a new Chair who currently holds an elected officer position on the GPT Board, a special election may be held to re-elect the officers.
- Marilyn Salas was welcomed back after receiving a reappointment to the Board.
- Richard Olmo requested for any update the use of the Excavation Kits for the "Amot Hunters" Grant.
   Joe Quinata had instructed the applicant to contact Richard Olmo directly.
- New staff members Andrew Tenorio and Anjelica Okada Roscoe were welcomed.
- Legal Counsel Terrence Brooks reported the Probate has been reopened for the Rosario House Property and the petition to approve the sale has begun. As part of the process, notice requirements need to be met and 30-45 days is allowed for responses.

### 9.0 ADJOURNMENT

With no further agenda items or discussion, Rebecca Duenas motioned to adjourn the meeting. The motion was seconded by Richard Olmo and unanimously approved. The meeting adjourned at 5:05 p.m.
