### A SENATE RESOLUTION

To support alternative regional transportation between Guam and the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands through ferry service or by similar vessels.

**WHEREAS**, there is currently no alternatives to inter-island transportation other than air transportation between Guam and the CNMI; and

WHEREAS, due to the increasing demands of transporting goods and services as well as providing additional means of transportation, the addition of ferry services or similar vessels will be highly beneficial to the promotion of inter-island trade between Guam and the CNMI; and

WHEREAS, by providing alternative means of transportation through ferry services or similar vessels, Guam and the CNMI would ultimately expand the tourism market as well as infuse new money into its economies; and

WHEREAS, ferry service will not just supplement air travel; its capabilities can be utilized as a source of inter-island commuter service for work, delivery service, tourist attraction and may be used for emergency responses; and

**WHEREAS**, Guam Senator Tina Barnes introduced Resolution 279-32 which supports the promotion of an affordable alternative regional transportation between Guam and the CNMI by means of ferry service or other similar vessel and cargo service; and

WHEREAS, the Association of Pacific Island Legislatures, in its recent board of directors meeting, unanimously adopted Resolution 54-BOD-07, which promoted the idea of an affordable alternative regional transportation between Guam and the CNMI by means of a

commuter and cargo vessel service; and

**WHEREAS**, the Commonwealth Office of Transit Authority (COTA) was created to oversee the transportation system in the CNMI and would be the regulating entity for the ferry system in the CNMI; and

**WHEREAS,** by diligently working to build a strong partnership with the public and private sectors and through the regulation from the COTA, ferry service connecting the island of Guam and the CNMI is a very realistic possibility; and

WHEREAS, the CNMI is undoubtedly committed to the development of its interisland trade services through alternative transportation by ferry or similar vessels to connect our islands and truly become one Pacific Island nation; and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** by the Senate of the Eighteenth Northern Marianas Commonwealth Legislature, that the Senate hereby supports alternative regional transportation between Guam and the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands through ferry service or by similar vessels; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Senate President shall certify, and the Senate Legislative Secretary shall attest to the adoption of this Resolution and the Senate Clerk thereafter transmit certified copies to the Honorable Thomas J. Camacho, Special Assistant, Commonwealth Office of Transit Authority; the Honorable Judith T. Won Pat, Speaker, 32<sup>nd</sup> Guam Legislature; the Honorable Ralph DLG. Torres, President of the Senate; the Honorable Joseph P. Deleon Guerrero, Speaker, Eighteenth House of Representatives; the Honorable Eloy S. Inos, Governor, Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands; and the Honorable Gregorio "Kilili" Camacho Sablan, CNMI Delegate to the United States Congress.
