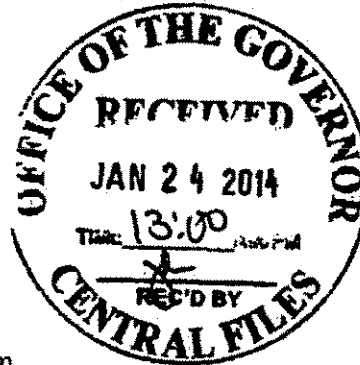

Alcohol and Substance Treatment Programs

The Guam Behavioral Health and Wellness Center (formerly Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse) contracts with non-profit organizations/entities providing substance abuse treatment services which expired on September 30, 2012, namely Salvation Army Lighthouse Recovery Center, Oasis Empowerment Center and Sanctuary, Inc. The Lighthouse Recovery Center provides substance treatment service for adult men, Oasis for adult women, and Sanctuary for adolescents (both genders). Service provided are residential (24/7) and Outpatient. The Lighthouse and Oasis provides an additional service called "social detoxification." Procurement efforts for Outpatient and Intensive Outpatient Substance Treatment for Adult Males and Females are near completion with notices of intent to award issued for RFP 08-2013 while Residential and Social Detoxification Substance Treatment are under technical review and compliance.

These services are mandated by 10 GCA §86101 and currently 28 residential clients will be affected and would require placement immediately if the services are discontinued for non-payment. GBHWC does not have adequate facilities and staff to comply with this mandate.

Therefore, there exist a threat to the public health, welfare and safety of these clients and thereby I declare a state of emergency at the Guam Behavioral Health & Wellness Center. Accordingly, I am authorizing emergency procurement as permitted by Section 5215, 5 GCA, Chapter 5 for the continuance of the services specified in the expired contracts of the non-profit organizations mentioned above with payments from appropriate local and federal funds.

I certify under penalty of perjury that the facts stated herein are true and that this statement of emergency is not being used solely for the purpose of avoidance of the provisions of Title 5, Guam Code Annotated, Chapter 5, of the Guam Procurement Law.

This emergency declaration is effective upon the approval and shall expire ninety (90) days from date of signature by the Governor of Guam, or expire upon award to the successful offerors for Outpatient and Intensive Outpatient Substance Treatment and Residential and Social Detoxification Substance Treatment for Adults and Adolescents.
