PROGRAM SCHEDULED ACTIVITIES FOR THIS REPORTING QUARTER

In collaboration with the Program Manager, Shelter Managers, Caseworker, Shelter Workers and other agencies and organizations, monthly activities and plans are developed throughout the Guma San Jose Program.

GSJ assisted a total of one hundred twenty-five (125) cases or three hundred four (304) individuals during the 2nd reporting quarter.

January 9, 2014 - Four clients attended the money management class held at the Salvation Army in Tiyan.

January 12, 2014 – Guma San Jose staff had their Christmas party. Only one staff did not attend.

January 18, 2014 - The clients were transported to attend Saint John Episcopal Church sponsored monthly dinner serving held at their parish hall.

January 21, 2014 - New Covenant Life Church sponsored a dinner serving held at GSJ lanai.

January 22, 2014 – Diana Calvo presented a donated vehicle to a couple with their three children for being model clients in GSJ. Clients entered GJS and did everything they had to do and exited the program before their 60th day was up. They were very cooperative and they followed the rules, got employed and moved into a house. They met all their goals.

March 5, 2014 - PM attended a GRTA Advisory Committee meeting in Hagatna.

March 6, 2014 - Four clients attended a money management class held at the Salvation Army in Tiyan.

March 28, 2014 – PM and SM had a meeting with the Dededo clients reminding them of the rules, health and hygiene, their goals and objectives, other resources and others.

March 29, 2014 – Fourteen clients attended the Diabetes Alert Day Health Fair held at the Micronesia Mall.

March 30, 2014 – Clients assisted staff and worked in the yard and cleaned inside of the Dededo Shelter preparing for the WHIAAPI visit.

PM is supervising an Intern from the University of Guam.

PM participated in CSS grant meetings with ED and PR.

PM is redoing the Intake application and Individual Service Plan goals and objectives.

PM and SMs continue to counsel clients with challenging issues, etc.

PM continues to work with staff and provide training.

TRAINING/CONFERENCE:

January 10, 2014 – GSJ staff met and had a training on HIV, STD and universal precaution.

January 14, 2014 - Program Manager, Shelter Manager and Caseworker attended the Point in Time Homeless Count training held at CSS main conference room.

January 15, 2014 - Program Manager and Caseworker attended the Point in Time Homeless Count team leader training held at CSS main conference room.

February 19, 2014 - Two (2) GSJ staff attended a fire extinguisher training held at CSS ADC Center.

February 22, 2014 – Four (4) GSJ staff attended First Aid/CPR recertification training held at the PNG Day Care Center in Tamuning.

March 19 - 20, 2014 - Caseworker attended the 2014 Social Work Regional Training Conference "Behavioral Health in Micronesia: Challenges and Opportunities for Social Work" held at Guam Marriott Resort and Spa. Attendees were given certificates.

March 22, 2014 – Program Manager attended a Veterans forum at the Tamuning Senior Citizen Center.

March 24 - 26, 2014 - A Shelter Manager attended the Palliative Care Training for caregivers held at the Outrigger Hotel in Tumon.

March 26, 2014 - A Shelter Worker attended the new employee orientation at CSS.

C. PROGRAM FUNCTIONS:

DEDEDO SHELLTER

Placement:

Fifteen (15) cases or forty-seven (47) individuals were able to move in with families and friends.

Three (3) cases or thirteen (13) individuals were able to find a place to rent on their own.

One (1) case or two (2) individuals was able to find employment.

One (1) case or one (1) individual was accepted into GHURA Public Housing Program.

One (1) case or five (5) individuals was accepted into Salvation Army Emergency Solutions Grant program for rental assistance.

Emergency Room:

Nine (9) cases or twenty-four (24) individuals were housed overnight. They had to check out the following day because there were no available beds.

Walk in Assistance:

Four (4) cases or six (6) individuals came to GSJ and were given food and personal hygiene products.

Eviction:

One (1) case or two (2) individuals (a couple) was evicted on January 22, 2014. They violated too many rules and also violated their contract.

One (1) case or individual was evicted on January 31, 2014. Client was a Guam Behavioral & Wellness Center referral. Client had too many issues, became disruptive, didn't want to follow instructions, rules, tried to break a phone by throwing it on the floor, harassed staff and GPD had to be called for removal.

Resignation:

Four (4) cases or sixteen (16) individuals were offered shelter but never returned.

Challenges:

The shelter is still facing some structural challenges with the roof and ceiling. We estimated that 25% of the ceiling is cracking and leaking. Last year 50% of the ceiling leaked and a contractor repaired it. A month after the repair some of the cracks started to appear again and the leaks followed. One room is still closed because the water leaks through the fan/light fixture and it's a safety hazard. The rainy season is just around the corner and we believe the leaking problem will be worse than last year.

The Dededo Shelter is always full and most of the clients are families with several children. Many of them do not have a high school education and have no means of transportation. Many can't work because they have no childcare. Some were previously involved with the law and can't get hired. Some have mental illness or substance abuse issues and are on disability. Many have limited English skills and thus it will not be easy for them to find work, and the list goes on and on.

ORDOT SHELTER

On January 30, 2014, Department of Public Works, Government of Guam authorized the Men's Shelter/Guma San Jose to relocate from Barrigada to Ordot pending the completion of all the required renovations and documents needed for the Department of Public Works and Fire Department inspection paperwork. The shelter is housing five (5) single men at this time.

Right Wing kitchen counter - materials and labor was donated by Mr. Mejares one of the Shelter Worker's father.

Left Wing kitchen counter - materials were purchased by GSJ donation funds. Labor was provided by Guma San Jose staff and clients.

Pending Work During the 1st Quarter:

The plumbing work still needs to be completed by Support Service Division, electrical work by KEYS Construction needs to be inspected by Support Service Division, 7 window screens need to be repaired or replaced, a cracked glass window needs to be replaced, 4 screen doors need to be replaced and front and back tin roofs need be replaced. For safety and security purposes we would need to install window security bars for all the windows or at least 4 for the front windows.

When the renovation is completed, the Department of Public Works and the Fire Department would have to do an inspection. If all goes well then the shelter could increase the number of male clients from 5 to 10 and two additional clients could utilize the Emergency Room for an overnight stay.

Shelter Update:

The Ordot Shelter is still being operated with a temporary agreement between the Department of Public Works and CSS pending an inspection by DPW and the Guam Fire Department. An inspection will be scheduled upon completion of the following:

1). Electrical certification by K.E.Y.S Construction, 2). Installation of smoke detectors in the bedrooms, 3). Installation of four (4) safety screen doors for the front entrance and back, 4), Repair of two (2) ceiling light fixtures, 5). Repair exit lights, 6). Fire extinguishers are returned and put in place, 7). Replace a glass window, 8). Install two (2) back flow water spouts, and 9). A final inspection is completed.

The Ordot Shelter is only using one side of the duplex building until we pass the inspection. With half of the building being used, we continue to house five (5) single male clients and one (1) ER (emergency room) client.

The shelter will be able to house ten (10) single male clients and two (2) ER clients after we pass the inspection and we receive a go ahead from the ED.

Activities:

Staff and clients at the Ordot Shelter continue to work on the needs of the shelter in preparation of the upcoming inspection by Public Works and Guam Fire Department.

Placement:

Three (3) cases or three (3) individuals were able to find a place with family or friends.

One (1) case or one (1) individual was able to find a place to rent on his own.

One (1) case or individual found employment as a security guard and still in the program trying to secure housing.

Two (2) cases or two (2) individuals were assisted with transportation, police and court clearances, X ray, Health certificate, assisted with SNAP, MIP, hair cut and assisted both in securing employment before exiting the program.

Emergency Room:

Fourteen (14) cases or fourteen (14) individuals were housed overnight. They had to check out the following day because there were no available beds.

Resignation:

Two (2) cases or two (2) individuals were offered shelter but never returned.

Eviction:

A male individual was housed on January 15, 2014. He was evicted on February 14, 2014 for non compliance of house rules and policies. The individual is also a client of Guam Behavioral Health and Wellness Center.

D. SERVICES PROVIDED:

Sixty-one (61) cases or one hundred five (105) individuals were provided with three thousand one hundred eighty-nine (3189) meals. Fifty-six (56) cases or one hundred twenty-three (123) individuals were provided with four hundred eighty-three (483) transportation services. The clients made a total of seven hundred eighty-five (785) phone calls.

Transportation services were provided to and from both shelters; to job sites, job searches, job interviews, Catholic Social Service Office, home searches, workshops, sponsored dinners, The Salvation Army, Mayor's Offices, Superior Court, Guam Public Guardian, DPHSS, GMHA, DMHSA, AHRD, DOL, DOE, DISID, GHURA, super markets, etc.

Follow ups were made with GHURA and The Salvation Army regarding applications for housing assistance. Follow ups were also made on applications that were submitted to various employers for employment via phone calls and transporting clients to and from the job sites.
