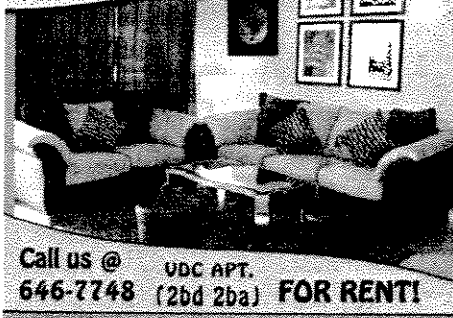

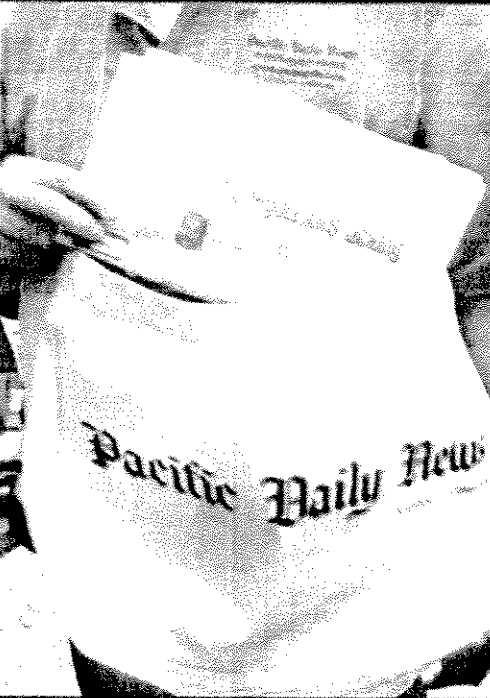

Rev & Tax rescinds 135 gaming machine licenses

THE Department of Revenue and Taxation completed its inventory of licensed gaming machines on Guam early last week and determined that 318 machines are eligible to be licensed, according to Marie Benito, deputy director of the Department of Revenue and Taxation. That number is a drop from the 453 machines that the department had licensed as of early August.

With the enactment of Public Law 32-60 on July 8, licenses were to be issued for machines that had been licensed on Guam prior to Aug. 1, 2001.

"After a thorough inventory was conducted, the licensing staff realized their mistake of issuing [licenses to] 400 Liberty machines," Benito said. "The [number of] records we could clearly identify as Liberty machines were 265. We had to invalidate 135 machines because licenses were mistakenly issued by the department. It's unfortunate that previous records could not be located, and some were registered under video machines and lacking in description."

The revoked licenses had been issued to machines belonging to Guam Music Inc. On Aug. 2, licenses were issued for 53 machines belonging to Atlas Amusement Enterprises, the documents for which are in

order, Benito said.

The owner of the machines that were declared ineligible has been notified and told to identify and remove 135 machines from the business locations within 30 days of Sept. 10, Benito said. "[Alcoholic Beverage Control] inspectors will inspect the establishments to ensure that the machines are removed and also remove the tag that identifies the registration of the machine," she said. "The owners have been cooperative in our efforts to correct this problem."

Attorney General Leonardo Rapadas contends that the machines are illegal under Guam law. On Aug. 15, he filed an amended complaint for declaratory judgment with the Superior Court of Guam, urging the court to revoke the gaming machine licenses and prohibit the issuance of new licenses.

The court has yet to rule as procedural deadlines have not passed. "The non-governmental parties had 20 days to respond," said a spokeswoman for Rapadas' office. "The governmental parties have 60 days to respond, so their answers are due on Oct. 14."

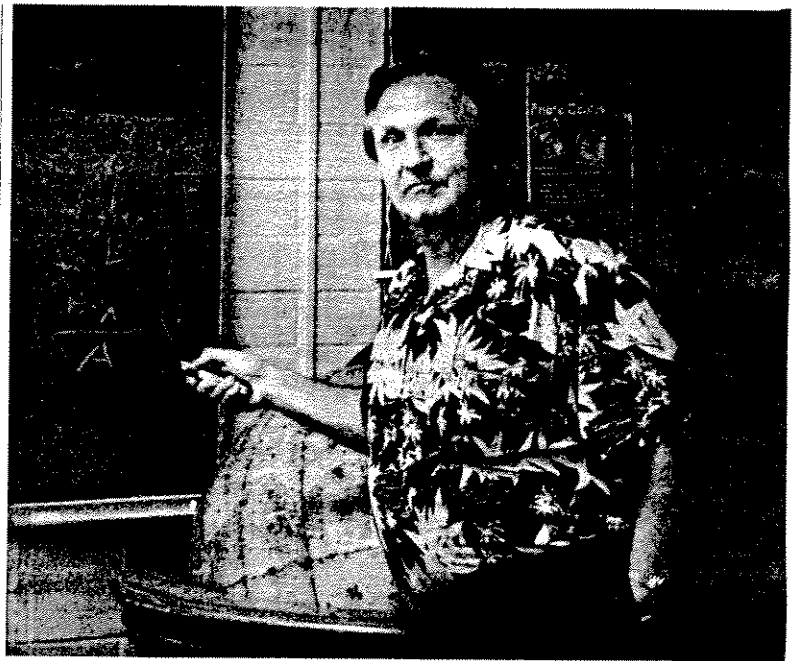

Alternative energy for Guam proposed

TED Jaguszyn, managing director of CoTherm of America Corp., made a presentation yesterday at the University of Guam Marine Lab to introduce his patented Drilled Hydrothermal Energy (DHE) concept, which involves drilling to obtain thermal energy from the ocean of any large body of water.

CoTherm focuses on innovating, developing and commercializing systems in the sustainable energy field.

Instead of laying pipes beneath the ocean, DHE involves drilling protected seawater conduits from the point of application

directly to the cold and warm seawater resources. According to the company, this application borrows mature underground technologies from the petroleum, geothermal and hydroelectric industries.

Jaguszyn arrived on Guam last week after participating at the International Ocean Thermal Energy Conversion Symposium in Honolulu, Hawaii where he did a presentation on "Seawater Conduits for Ocean Thermal Energy Conversion and Seawater Air Conditioning: Drilled Hydrothermal Energy."

During his presentation at UOG, he stressed the benefits of utilizing the technol-

ogy, including tapping ocean resources for power and cooling as well as the possibility of going into seaweed farming which could provide biomass for local biofuel production, among other benefits or revenue streams.

CoTherm has principals and a network of science advisors with experience in the heating, ventilation and air-conditioning markets and related research fields.

Since last week, Jaguszyn has been meeting with entities such as the Guam Power Authority to explore the possibility of utilizing DHE technology on Guam for more sustainable energy generation.

Court denies Shipyard insurance claim

GUAM Industrial Services Inc., which does business as Guam Shipyard, on Friday lost its bid in federal court for insurance coverage for the sinking of its dry dock in January 2011.

Guam Shipyard and Mathews Pothen, CEO of Guam, had filed suit May 26, 2011 against Zurich American Insurance Co. and Starr Indemnity & Liability Co. claiming it had been improperly denied insurance coverage of the sinking under policies it held on the dry dock which is also known as Big Blue or The Machinist.

Hatches on the dry dock had been left open overnight and high surf got into the vessel's

compartments, causing the vessel to submerge. The dry dock has since been refloated and repaired.

The shipyard claimed it was entitled, under its policy, to salvage costs incurred and damages to the dry dock in the amount of \$6.88 million. The shipyard also claimed in court that it was entitled to damages in the amount of \$394,321 under a separate liability policy that included coverage for pollution.

The court determined that the shipyard had "warranted" that the dry dock was U.S. Navy-certified and the certification maintained. "The Machinist was not U.S. Navy-certified at the time of the accident. Nor was it ever," according

to court documents. The lack of certification was a breach of the insurance policy, "and Defendants Zurich and Starr may rightfully deny coverage," the court said.

In denying coverage under the liability policy, the court said: "The policy provides coverage only where there is either damage to another's property or the actual discharge of oil. ... Here, only Guam Shipyard's property was damaged, and no oil was actually discharged."

The insurance companies had also filed claims seeking the denial of claims, which the court granted. The companies' complaint also seeks costs and other "appropriate relief" which were not addressed by Friday's decision.
