

AN ACT TO AMEND SUBSECTION (f) AND ADD A NEW SUBSECTION (g) TO §3301 OF CHAPTER 3, TITLE 16, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO ESTABLISHING SPEED LIMITS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- 2 Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds
- 3 that the Department of Public Works is responsible for the design and construction
- 4 of the island's roadways, and should therefore be responsible for establishing and
- 5 posting speed limits that promote safety for vehicles, bicyclists and pedestrians that
- 6 traverse the island's roadways.

Subsection (f) of § 3301 of Chapter 3, Title 16, Guam Code Section 2. Annotated, is hereby amended to read: 2

"(f) The Chief of Police is hereby authorized to designate as may be reasonably necessary, and on a temporary or intermittent basis, certain areas as limited speed areas and to mark such areas with appropriate warning signs. No vehicle shall be operated in such areas in excess of the maximum speeds as may be indicated by such signs."

Section 3. A new Subsection (g) is hereby *added* to § 3301 of Chapter 3, Title 16, Guam Code Annotated, to read:

- "(g) the Director of the Department of Public Works is hereby authorized to establish and post permanent speed limits on primary and secondary roadways as defined in Chapter 5 of this Title. For any change to speed limits on a secondary roadway, the Director of the Department of Public Works shall request the input of the Mayor(s) of the municipality or village where the secondary roadway affected by the proposed speed limit change is located. The Mayor(s) may provide a response to the Director of the Department of Public Works within ten (10) calendar days from the date of receipt of the request for input. The Director of the Department of Public Works shall keep on record, copies of all submitted requests for input and all responses to such requests."
- Section 4. Effective Date. This Act shall become effective upon its enactment.
- Severability. If any provision of this Law or its application to Section 5. any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Law which can be given effect without the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this Law are severable.
