**AN ACT TO AMEND SUBSECTION (f) AND ADD A NEW
SUBSECTION (g) TO §3301 OF CHAPTER 3, TITLE 16, GUAM
CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO ESTABLISHING SPEED
LIMITS.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** *I Liheslaturan Guáhan* finds
3 that the Department of Public Works is responsible for the design and construction
4 of the island's roadways, and should therefore be responsible for establishing and
5 posting speed limits that promote safety for vehicles, bicyclists and pedestrians that
6 traverse the island's roadways.

1 **Section 2.** Subsection (f) of § 3301 of Chapter 3, Title 16, Guam Code
2 Annotated, is hereby *amended* to read:

3 “(f) The Chief of Police is hereby authorized to designate as may be
4 reasonably necessary, and on a temporary or intermittent basis, certain areas
5 as limited speed areas and to mark such areas with appropriate warning signs.
6 No vehicle shall be operated in such areas in excess of the maximum speeds
7 as may be indicated by such signs.”

8 **Section 3.** A new Subsection (g) is hereby *added* to § 3301 of Chapter 3,
9 Title 16, Guam Code Annotated, to read:

10 “(g) the Director of the Department of Public Works is hereby
11 authorized to establish and post permanent speed limits on primary and
12 secondary roadways as defined in Chapter 5 of this Title. For any change to
13 speed limits on a secondary roadway, the Director of the Department of
14 Public Works *shall* request the input of the Mayor(s) of the municipality or
15 village where the secondary roadway affected by the proposed speed limit
16 change is located. The Mayor(s) may provide a response to the Director of
17 the Department of Public Works within ten (10) calendar days from the date
18 of receipt of the request for input. The Director of the Department of Public
19 Works *shall* keep on record, copies of all submitted requests for input and all
20 responses to such requests.”

21 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Act *shall* become effective upon its
22 enactment.

23 **Section 5. Severability.** *If* any provision of this Law or its application to
24 any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such
25 invalidity *shall not* affect other provisions or applications of this Law which can be
26 given effect without the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the
27 provisions of this Law are severable.


