





AN ACT TO AMEND SUBSECTION (a) OF § 80105, CHAPTER 80, DIVISION 4 OF TITLE 10, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO PROVIDING FOR A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE GUAM MEMORIAL HOSPITAL VOLUNTEERS ASSOCIATION TO SERVE AS AN EX-OFFICIO MEMBER OF THE GUAM MEMORIAL HOSPITAL AUTHORITY BOARD OF TRUSTEES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- 2 Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. The Guam Memorial
- 3 Hospital Volunteers Association (GMHVA) has historically played an important

role in providing invaluable services and needed resources to the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority (GMHA). Established in 1965 as a non-profit corporation for the primary purpose of supporting Guam's only public hospital, the GMHVA has raised and donated in excess of Ten Million Dollars (\$10,000,000) in funds and equipment. For over forty-nine years, the dedicated members of the GMHVA have consistently demonstrated their unwavering commitment to promoting and enhancing the services and resources of the Guam Memorial Hospital. In times of need, they could always be counted on in being at the forefront and doing whatever it takes to help address the needs and challenges being encountered by GMHA.

I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds that it is appropriate that a representative of the Guam Memorial Hospital Volunteers Association should be a full member of the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority Board of Trustees.

Section 2. Subsection (a) of § 80105 [Board of Trustees] of Chapter 80, Division 4, Title 10, Guam Code Annotated, is hereby *amended* to read:

"(a) The governance and control of the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority are vested in a Board of Trustees (Board). The Board *shall* be composed of ten (10) members: four (4) members representing the general public, who *shall* possess a background and experience in healthcare, management, finance or any other business-related field; one (1) member representing the Allied Health Professions; two (2) members representing the Guam Nursing Association; and two (2) members representing the Guam Medical Community, appointed by *I Maga'lahen Guåhan* as provided herein, with the advice and consent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*. In addition, one (1) member who *shall* be the President, or designee, of the Guam Memorial Hospital Volunteers Association, who *shall* be an ex-officio member with full participatory rights and privileges, but without the right of voting. The GMH Volunteers Association President or designee *shall* have

1	been a member of the GMH Volunteers Association for a minimum of five
2	(5) years prior to assuming a position on the Board."
3	Section 3. Severability. If any provision of this law or its application to
4	any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such
5	invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this law which can be
6	given effect without the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the
7	provisions of this law are severable.
8	Section 4. Effective Date. This Act shall become effective upon its
