



**AN ACT TO APPROVE AND ADOPT THE CAPITAL
IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS (CIP) SCHEDULE AND
LAND USE DESIGNATIONS IN THE JOSE D. LEON
GUERRERO COMMERCIAL PORT OF GUAM
MASTER PLAN UPDATE 2013 REPORT.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Approval and Adoption of the Capital Improvement**
3 **Projects Schedule.**

4 (a) The Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) Schedule (Table 5-1: CIP
5 Schedule, page 5-10 of the MPU 2013) in the Jose D. Leon Guerrero
6 Commercial Port of Guam Master Plan Update (MPU) 2013 Report (Exhibit
7 A) is approved, with the following recommendations:

1 (1) *I Liheslatura* (the Legislature) recommends that the Port
2 focus near term on the definition and priorities for its Sustainability
3 Projects and the to-be-scheduled sustainability projects, and to include
4 Berth F-1, G-Pier, and H-Wharf as critical to preserving marine
5 industrial capabilities in the CIP Schedule.

6 (2) Port investments and the supporting tariff adjustments
7 related to this approved CIP Schedule are subject to Title 12 GCA,
8 Chapter 12 (Public Utilities Commission and the Telecommunications
9 Act of 2004), and the debt ceiling limit established by Public Law 30-
10 57.

11 **Section 2. Approval and Adoption of the Commercial Port and**
12 **Vicinity Land Use Designation.** The Commercial Port and Vicinity Land Use
13 Designation (Figure 2-3, Page 2-10, PAG MPU 2013) in the Jose D. Leon
14 Guerrero Commercial Port of Guam Master Plan Update (MPU) 2013 (Exhibit A)
15 Report is hereby approved and adopted.

16 **Section 3. MPU 2013 Report Supersedes and Complements.** The Jose
17 D. Leon Guerrero Commercial Port of Guam Master Plan Update 2013 Report
18 (Exhibit A) supersedes and complements the previously approved Jose D. Leon
19 Guerrero Commercial Port of Guam Master Plan Update 2007 Report. As such, it
20 supports facility improvement projects thus far accomplished, or currently
21 underway, and the land use designations.

22 **Section 4. Severability.** *If* any provision of this Law or its application to
23 any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such
24 invalidity *shall not* affect other provisions or applications of this Law which can be
25 given effect without the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the
26 provisions of this Law are severable.

I request that Bill 328-32, 'An Act To Approve And Adopt The CIP Schedule And Land Use Designations In The Jose D. Leon Guerrero Commercial Port Of Guam Master Plan Update 2013 Report', be placed on the Agenda.

It is also requested that the public hearing requirement be waived pursuant to Section 6.04(d)(1) of *I Liheslatura's* Standing Rules and 2 GCA §2103(a) ("... in the event the bill is identical to a bill introduced earlier, which later bill received a public hearing, then a public hearing for the identical bill may be waived."). Bill 328-32 is identical to Bill 283-32 (An Act To Approve And Adopt The Jose D. Leon Guerrero Commercial Port Authority Of Guam (Port) Master Plan Update 2013 Report). Bill 283-32 received a public hearing on March 13, 2014, and a Committee Report was issued on April 3, 2014.
