
Subject: Request for Certificate of Emergency for
Telephone Services for the Department of Public Health and Social
Services and the Guam Fire Department



Attached is a memorandum from the Directors of the Department of Public Health and Social Services and the Guam Fire Department informing the General Services Agency that the current provider of telephone services has failed to comply with the Notice of Default that was issued to them on May 30, 2014. We are requesting for an emergency declaration to provide continued telephone services for a period of three (3) months.

Both the Department of Public Health and Social Services and the Guam Fire Department are both agencies that are responsible for either health, safety or the welfare of the people of Guam. An important part of their services is the need for telephonic communications. The current bidder has failed to ensure that it has met the requirements of the bid and as such, the General Services Agency has determined that a termination is in the best interest of the territory.

Based upon the facts provided by the Department, I, ROBERT H. KONO, Acting Chief Procurement Officer for the General Services Agency do certify under penalty of perjury, that a certificate of emergency is not being used solely for the purpose of avoidance of the provisions of Title 5, Guam Code Annotated, Chapter 5, the Guam Procurement law.
