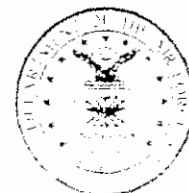
ACCOMPLISHMENTS

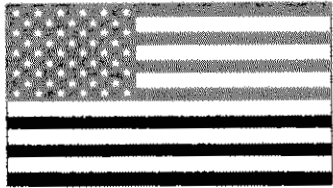
ACCOMPLISHMENTS
