





RE: Waiver of Public Hearing for Bill 350-32 (LS)

Dear Speaker Won Pat:

Håfa adai! Yesterday, I introduced Bill 350-32 (LS) to provide much needed money to the Guam Police Department to pay past due overtime owed to their officers. A copy of Bill 350-32 is enclosed for your reference. I request that the public hearing for Bill 350-32 (LS) be waived for placement on this current session agenda pursuant to the authority provided to you in §2103 of Chapter 2, Title 2 Guam Code Annotated.

The excessive overtime hours performed by our hardworking police officers takes its toll on their health and wellbeing, which in turn poses a hazard to the safety and welfare of the people of Guam. I acknowledge that providing these funds for past due overtime payments won't directly solve the officer shortage problem. It will, however, provide a much-needed boost in morale that will give our officers a renewed push to continue to sacrifice their time and energy to keep all of us safe. Not paying officer overtime poses a significant risk to the safety of the people of Guam.

Our police officers deserve that their overtime be paid, and the people of Guam deserve a police force that receives just compensation for their continued hard work. We cannot allow our police officers to lose faith in their government's ability to pay them. They, and the people they protect, deserve better. I hope you positively consider my request. Thank you for your time.
