Buenas yan Hafa Adai! Pursuant to 5 GCA Section 5225 "Emergency Procurement" attached is a copy of a Certificate of Emergency signed by the Governor to allow for the continuation of the Elderly Nutrition Program and Home Delivery Meals for up to three (3) months.

On July 3, 2014, the General Services Agency after an exhaustive review, determined that the lowest bidder was financial responsible for providing the services in a manner that ensures that it will be able to comply with the bid requirements. After the issuance of a "Notice of Intent to Award" was issued on the 7th, another bidder protested the award on the 10th of July, thereby placing a "stay" or "hold" on the bid until a determination is made on the protest. After review and determination, the General Services Agency denied the protest on the 15th, and received by the protestor on the 16th. The General Services Agency cannot award for a period of fifteen days after the notification, since an appeal may be filed, thereby requiring this emergency request for another month. Three months is stated in case of an appeal.

Attached is a memorandum from the Director of the Department of Public Health and Social Services' Division of Senior Citizens requesting for an emergency declaration to provide continued food services; to the senior citizens for up to three (3) months.

One part of the program provides over seven hundred (700) hot meals a day to seniors at senior centers, while the home delivery provides over eleven hundred forty-four (1144) meals a day. For many of the seniors receiving this service, this is perhaps the one balanced meal that they will receive on any service day.

On July 3, 2014, the General Services Agency after an exhaustive review, determined that the lowest bidder was financial responsible for providing the services in a manner that ensures that it will be able to comply with the bid requirements. After the issuance of a Notice of an Intent to Award was sent on the 7th, a protest came in on the 10th, thereby delaying the award. After review and determination, the General Services Agency denied the protest on the 15th and received on the 16th. The General Services Agency cannot award for a period of fifteen days after the notification, thereby requiring this emergency request for another month.

Based upon the facts provided by the Department, I, CLAUDIA S. ACFALLE, Chief Procurement Officer for the General Services Agency do certify under penalty of perjury, that a certificate of emergency is not being used solely for the purpose of avoidance of the provisions of Title 5, Guam Code Annotated, Chapter 5, the Guam Procurement law.





Congregate Meals (C1) and Home-Delivered Meals (C2)

Buenas! This is to request for your approval for Emergency Procurement to ensure the continuation of Title III Nutrition Services more commonly referred to as the Elderly Nutrition Program (ENP), Congregate (C1) and Home-Delivered Meals (C2) that are being provided S.H. Enterprises, Inc. through an emergency procurement will expire on Thursday, July 30, 2014.

The Elderly Nutrition Program ensures the provision of a hot, nutritious meal that provides a minimum of 33 and 1/3 percent of the current Recommended Dietary Allowance, as established by the Food and Nutrition Board of the National Academy of Sciences, National Research Council to seniors who access one of the 14 congregate meals sites or those who have been determined by our Case Management Services program to be homebound. The Congregate component or C1 of the ENP provides for approximately 780 seniors while the Home-Delivered component or C2 provides for approximately 1,180 homebound seniors, a combined total of approximately 1,960 seniors. For many seniors who access this meal service, this is perhaps the one balanced meal they will receive on any service day of this program.

The procurement of these services through and Emergency Procurement as under 5 G.C.A. §5215 is necessary in order to avert a threat to the health, welfare and safety of our seniors who rely on this meal at either the designated congregate sites or at their home.

The Department of Public Health and Social Services (DPH&SS), Division of Senior Citizens (DSC) is working with the General Services Agency (GSA) to procure these services through the Invitation for Bid (IFB) process.
