

INTRODUCTIONS:

Marlene recommended that the discussion to discuss Bus Operations during emergencies be discussed. Bruce Williams, DOE; Frank Taitano, Supt. Of Bus Operations DPW and Francisco Paulino of Navy Operations were invited to bring up their concerns. Mr. Williams gave an update on the status of discussions that had taken place between the three agencies.

The issue at hand was who had responsibility at an accident site. For reporting purposes Mr. Williams had developed a data form that contained informational data on the affected individuals which were usually minors on one side and on the opposite side a listing of protocols that is to be used as a guide/checklist.

After discussion Chairperson Perez recommended that the group revisit the different perspectives and develop an SOP which all parties agree to and submit to legal for review. Legal counsel had recommended a separate meeting to discuss and iron out issues. Chairperson Perez had assigned Marlene Carbullido to administer the joint meeting.
