Dear Governor Calvo and Speaker Won Pat:


Public Law 32-068 permits the Office of the Attorney General to transfer between object class allocation provided notification to the Governor and Speaker of the Guam Legislature is made at least fifteen (15) days prior to such modification.

The transfer is necessary to cover anticipated travel and lodging expenses for victims to testify at the sentencing hearing for the recent trial related to the Tumon incident. This also includes the anticipated shortfall in the other categories for the remaining fiscal year.
