

AN ACT TO DE-APPROPRIATE SEVENTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$75,000) FROM THE SUMS APPROPRIATED TO *I LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN* (THE GUAM LEGISLATURE), AND RE-APPROPRIATE SEVENTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$75,000) TO THE GUAM MEMORIAL HOSPITAL AUTHORITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- 2 Section 1. The sum of Seventy-five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000) is de-
- 3 appropriated from the sums appropriated to I Liheslaturan Guåhan prior to
- 4 December 31, 2014, and re-appropriated to the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority
- 5 for: one (1) cryostat; two (2) BiPAP systems; and ten (10) infusion pumps.
- 6 Notwithstanding any other law or rule, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the Guam

- 1 Legislature is authorized to reduce the allotment to Senator Michael T. Limtiaco by
- 2 an amount equal to the sum de-appropriated by this Section.
