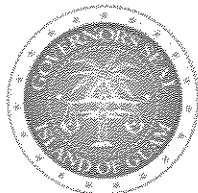

**Details:** Funding from this grant will be used towards the monitoring of the Ko'Ko' birds on Rota, CNMI. The endangered rail was released on the island in order to establish a population. This program focuses on the release methodology, determining appropriate release sites, as well as data collection on survivorship. In doing this, the monitoring techniques will provide more accurate population estimates on Rails on Rota. Funding will also include personnel, travel between islands, and contractual costs.
