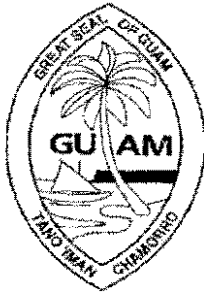

24 **COMES NOW**, Employee Franklin Bamba (hereinafter "Appellant"), by and through counsel,
 25 Cunliffe & Cook, by Jeffrey A. Moots, Esq., and Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority
 26 (hereinafter "Management"), by and through its counsel Cynthia V. Ecube, Esq. with The Law Office
 27 of Cynthia V. Ecube, Esq., and hereby stipulate as follows:

- 28 1. That Management shall immediately reinstate Employee Franklin Bamba to his prior position of employment with GHURA;
2. That Management shall compensate Employee Franklin Bamba for back wages in the amount of Forty-Nine Thousand Eight Hundred Fifty-Nine & 08/100 Dollars

4 (\$49,859.08) representing all the time from the date of termination on July 6, 2011 until
 5 the date of reinstatement, and that said amount of Forty-Nine Thousand Eight
 6 Hundred Fifty-Nine & 08/100 Dollars (\$49,859.08) shall reflect the full and final
 7 amount due to Appellant for all back wages due to him;

8 3. That Management shall credit Employee Franklin Bamba for all benefits, which shall
 9 include any leave and contributions made to the Government of Guam Retirement Fund
 10 representing all the time from the date of termination on July 6, 2011 until the date of
 11 reinstatement commensurate with the terms of this settlement; and,

12 4. That Management shall pay Employee Franklin Bamba's reasonable attorney's fees in the
 13 amount of Two Thousand Two Hundred & 00/100 Dollars(\$2,200.00). Said
 14 attorney's fees shall be paid directly to the Law Office of Cunliffe & Cook.


